## TREE SHAPING INSTRUCTIONS:

Shaping faux cedar trees is an easy process to maintain their realistic appearance. *Here are instructions for shaping your 24" and 36" faux cedar trees:*

---

NO . 1 Fluff the Branches: Gently fluff out the branches and foliage to give the tree a fuller and more natural appearance. Start from the bottom and work your way up, ensuring that each branch is separated and spread out.

NO . 2 Rotate the Tree: Spin the faux cedar tree in its pot or base to ensure that it appears full and balanced from all angles.

NO . 3 Consider Branch Density: If you have a 36" faux cedar tree and you desire a more open or airy look, you can gently pull some of the foliage away from the branches to create gaps. Conversely, for a denser appearance, push the foliage closer to the branches.

NO . 4 Check the Top: Ensure that the top of the tree is appropriately shaped. Cedar trees usually have a central leader, which is the main upright stem. Adjust any foliage at the top to mimic this natural feature.

NO . 5 Storage: When not in use, store your faux cedar tree in a cool, dry place to prevent any deformation or damage.
