WREATH SHAPING INSTRUCTIONS:

Shaping a faux cedar wreath is like shaping a garland. *Here are some steps to help you shape your faux cedar pine wreath:*

NO .1 Begin by laying your faux cedar pine wreath on a flat surface. This will allow you to see its current shape and make it easier to work with.

NO .2 Gently fluff and separate the branches of the wreath to give it a fuller and more realistic appearance. Like the garland, start from the base of the wreath and work your way towards the outer edges, gently pulling the branches outward.

NO .3 Our wreath has wired branches, so you can use them to your advantage by bending and shaping them to create your desired arrangement. You can shape the wreath into a classic circular form or play around with different shapes like a teardrop or oval.

NO .4 As you shape the wreath, take a step back occasionally to assess its appearance. Adjust the branches and foliage as needed to create a balanced and visually appealing wreath.

NO .5 To add extra texture and visual interest, you can incorporate additional elements such as faux berries, pinecones, or ornaments. Attach them to the wreath using floral wire, ensuring that they are securely fastened.

NO .6 Once you're satisfied with the shape and design of your faux cedar pine wreath, hang it up at your desired location. It can be on a door, wall, or even used as a centerpiece.
