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CARING FOR YOUR PIECES

WHEN TO REMOVE

Take your jewellery off when exercising. Our sweat can sometimes be a little acidic, and it can cause tarnishing occasionally (which can happen sporadically, as its caused by your hormones which affect the PH balance in your skin).

It is recommended to take more significant pieces of jewellery off when you go to bed at night.

STORING

Store each piece separately, so that they don't tangle, rub or scratch one another. Make sure chains and necklaces are fastened when storing to avoid tangling.

If you aren't wearing them, keep all of your pieces in the box they came in, as most will have anti-tarnish pads. If not, then try to keep them away from moisture and direct sunlight, as this speeds up the tarnishing process.

ALWAYS REMEMBER

Always try to apply any lotions or perfumes before you put your jewellery on.

Silver hates the hot tub and swimming. The chlorine can turn it black, and bleach and other strong cleaning products can also ruin your pieces. Don't leave your jewellery on the bathroom sink.

CLEANING

If your silver pieces do tarnish, here are a few cleaning techniques to consider:

Silver cloths are your jewellery's best friend. Gently rubbing with one of these will bring silver back to being shiny again. *Extra tip*; it's also recommended to give jewellery a good rinse and a dry afterwards, as the clothes contain polish which can irritate your skin.

You can give jewellery a wash by soaking it in a bowl of warm to hot water with a drop of washing-up liquid. Let the jewellery soak for 10 - 15 minutes, then gently scrub with a soft toothbrush, rinse it off and dry.

Silver Dip is another good option, which is a cleaning solution in which you dip your jewellery. Ensure you give it a good rinse afterwards, and always dry it properly.

TOP TIP

The jewellery you wear all the time will need less cleaning than pieces that sit in a box. The daily friction, and your natural oils, will help subtly keep them clean. This is why silver jewellery is perfect to be worn every day!
