CALLIGRAPHY & LETTERING CLASSES

Intro to Brush Pen Calligraphy

Brush pen calligraphy is a great way for beginners to learn the foundations of pointed pen calligraphy without being intimidated by traditional pens, nibs, or inks! This class is a great complement to Just A Dip, which features ink and nib. In this class you will learn the fundamental technique of pointed pen calligraphy, but use a brush pen to achieve the distinct thin and thick strokes of modern calligraphy. Brush pens are a great tool to use for on-the-go creativity. Learn how to hold a brush pen, the basic strokes to create letterforms, and work towards combining those letterforms to make words and sentences. The versatility of this type of calligraphy is endless! You will leave with two beginner-friendly brush pens, take-home guide sheets, and the know-how to continue your calligraphy journey! Introduction to Modern Calligraphy: Lowercase and Basics

If you're interested in learning pointed pen calligraphy with a modern twist, or just want to try something new, then Intro to Modern Calligraphy is for you! This class is geared towards beginners, even if you have never picked up a calligraphy pen before in your life, so don't be intimidated! We will cover the basics, including prepping your pen to take its first dip, understanding ink flow and pressure essential to pointed pen calligraphy, and the creation of basic script letterforms. Infused in this class will be the basic foundations to this centuries-old art form, which will provide you a solid starting place in creating modern calligraphy with your own style. You will walk away with the ability to replicate or produce your own lowercase alphabet, and the encouragement to practice and develop your own lettering style, all without having to have perfect handwriting! Basic supplies for this class will be provided and kits will be available for purchase if you'd like to practice your calligraphy at home (which is definitely encouraged)! Teacher: Risha Roa

Modern Calligraphy Intermediate: Uppercase and Play

Keep going in your calligraphy journey! This class is ideal if you've completed Beginners Modern Calligraphy: Lowercase + Basics or any similar beginners class in pointed pen calligraphy. We will build on the basic foundations and jump into learning uppercase letterforms, both traditional and capitals with a modern twist. This class is more about play, and you'll be introduced to a variety of mediums like colored inks, watercolor, and metallic inks. We'll work further to develop, embrace and refine your own style, and wrap it up by learning how to digitize your calligraphy. This is an easy way to apply your lettering to images for Facebook, Instagram, or print! Basic supplies for this class will be provided, but you are more than welcome to bring your own calligraphy supplies to class. Kits will also be available for purchase if you'd like to keep practicing your calligraphy at home. Teacher: Risha Roa

Faux-Calligraphy: Creating and Addressing Your Own Stationery

Do you want to make someone's day? Sending pretty mail can be simple, but more importantly, *fun*. In this class, we will learn faux-calligraphy, the hand-lettering technique to achieve the coveted calligraphy look without all the technicalities of actually learning calligraphy! We will also create our own stationery and use our new faux-calligraphy skills to address the envelopes to our favorite people. Teacher: Risha Roa

Intro to Copperplate Calligraphy

Learn the basics of Copperplate calligraphy style. Through practice and history, we will learn how this style became so popular in the eighteenth century and how it has come back to life nowadays. We will cover the basics, including the proper position when we sit down, papers, inks and how the ink flows, nibs and penholders, how to build letterforms, and warm up exercises. No previous experience is needed. This class will help us to build a foundation and a technique in pointed pen calligraphy. We will work all these aspects through the writing of a poem, which you will take home, plus the encouragement to keep practicing and exploring this ancient art that has influenced our way of writing till nowadays. Basic supplies for this class will be provided. Teacher: Marta Llorens

Capital Letters in Copperplate

Learn to work on the uppercase elements of Copperplate style. We'll practice the form essence, how to build the letterforms, warm up exercises, and how to flourish them. We will work these letters individually, studying them and how to make the proper shapes and movements thanks to the position of our body and tools. We will also learn how to connect these capital letters with their lowercase partners and how to play together and position them in a sentence or text.

This course is for those who know a bit of the copperplate calligraphy style or any pointed nib calligraphy and would like to keep improving their skills. Supplies will be provided and you'll take home two elbow copperplate nibs, a pen holder, and a booklet to keep practicing. Teacher: Marta Llorens
