# **Hand-Carve Cute Stamps**

Did you know you can easily design and carve your own rubber stamps? It's an excellent way to create one-of-a-kind cards and gift wrap, to personalize correspondence, and to mark special occasions on your calendar! Children's book illustrator Erica Sirotich (www.ericasirotich.com) will demonstrate how to create simple and cute images that are suitable for stamping, how to transfer them onto rubber, and how to use carving tools to bring your images to life. We'll go over the use of negative and positive space to give the same image different looks and styles. Students may work from their own designs, or choose from a selection of simple illustrations supplied by the instructor. Perfect for beginners. Tools will be provided. Students will walk away with their own hand-carved stamp mounted onto a wood handle, a hand-stamped greeting card, a sheet of hand-stamped gift wrap, and an instructional guide. Creative collaboration and play is encouraged at the end of the class. Feel free to bring designs to class with you, but be sure they are 2" x 2" or smaller. \*Because this class utilizes sharp-edged tools, it is not suitable for students under 14. ## Modern Calligraphy Intermediate: Uppercase + Play

Keep going in your calligraphy journey! This class is ideal if you've completed Beginners Modern Calligraphy: Lowercase + Basics or any similar beginners class in pointed pen calligraphy. We will build on the basic foundations of Beginners Modern Calligraphy and jump into learning uppercase letterforms, both traditional and capitals with a modern twist. This class is more about play, you'll be introduced to a variety of mediums like colored inks, watercolor, and metallic inks. And we'll work further to develop, embrace and refine your own style, and at the end we'll learn how to digitize your calligraphy. This is an easy way to apply your lettering to images for Facebook, Instagram, or print! Basic supplies for this class will be provided, but you are more than welcome to bring your own calligraphy supplies to class. #### Intro to Copperplate Calligraphy

Learn the basics of Copperplate calligraphy style. Through practice and history, we will learn how this style became so popular in the eighteenth century and how it came back to life nowadays. We will cover the basics, such as how to have a proper position when we sit down, papers, inks and how the ink flows, nibs and penholders, or how to build letterforms or warm up exercises. No previous experience is needed, this class will help us to have a foundation and a technique in pointed pen calligraphy. We will be working all these aspects through the writing of a poem, which you will take at home plus the encouragement to keep practicing and exploring this ancient world and how it has influenced in our way of writing till nowadays. ### Intro to Modern Calligraphy: Lowercase + Basics

If you're interested in learning pointed pen calligraphy with a modern twist, or just want to try something new - this class is for you! This class is geared toward beginners. Even if you have never picked up a calligraphy pen before don't be intimidated — we'll cover the basics, including prepping your pen to take its first dip, understanding ink flow and pressure essential to pointed pen calligraphy, and the creation of basic script letterforms. Infused in this class will be the basic foundation to this centuries-old form of art, which will provide you with a solid starting place in creating modern calligraphy with your own style. You will walk away with the ability to replicate or produce your own lowercase alphabet, and the encouragement to practice and develop your own lettering style — all without having to have perfect
