

Active Coat - Fitting instructions

Our Active Dog Coats are designed to perform in all conditions, whilst allowing for unrestricted movement. For optimum performance the Coat should initially be carefully fitted to your dog using the 'Adjustable Back Panel' or ABP.





ABP Safe seam

As you can see, the ABP is completely removable and facilitates up to 160mm of size adjustment. The Coat should be tailored to the individual dog's physique, be that a deep chest, or a narrow waist.

The underside of the Coat has a marked area where the seam can be safely cut through, to accommodate male dogs (Only if required).

Firstly, put the jacket on the dog. It should fit snuggly, but not be overly tight, and difficult to get on and off.

If it doesn't fit well, remove the Coat from the dog, and detach the ABP. Re-attach exposing more Velcro, for a looser fit, and less for a tighter fit.

Make the adjustments on both sides, so the jacket sits symmetrically, with the zip running down the middle of the dog's back.

Adjustments can also be made diagonally, to accommodate a deep chest, and small waist, for example.



Once the jacket is fitted use the central zip for putting on and removing the jacket.

Care Instructions

Hand wash in water and air dry away from direct heat source.
