AUTHORIZATION FOR BOROUGH TO SIGN SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BERGEN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen owns certain equipment, including a 2020 Elgin/Whirlwind 4 wheel vacuum sweeper ("Street Sweeper"); and

WHEREAS, subject to the operational needs of the County, the County seeks to make the Street Sweeper available to the municipalities within Bergen County for short term use; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights wishes to ensure its ability to rent the Street Sweeper from the County for use on the Municipality's roads when needed; and

WHEREAS, the County and Municipality have determined that by entering into this Shared Services Agreement governing the terms for renting the County's Street Sweeper in advance of Municipality's need to utilize the Street Sweeper, the parties will be able to facilitate the prompt availability of the Street Sweeper at such time as Municipality has a need to utilize it; and

WHEREAS, there is often insufficient time to execute formal agreements to enable the sharing of Equipment under such circumstances; and
