



"A paradox regarding identity over time - positing a scenario in which all the parts of a ship are replaced gradually and one at a time. Ultimately posing this question: Is the vessel that exists after the replacements the same ship as the vessel that existed before the replacements?"

Inspired by this provocative thought experiment, Theseus is a physical manifestation of the same - evoking the sentiment of being different yet familiar.

The collection draws parallels with the processes involved in dismantling, re-purposing & re-using elements - taking cues from Studio PKA's endeavour to recreate its workplace with the same materials however in a different space.
