#### PRICING:

- \$13,700 Per person based on two sharing. Single supplement cost applies.
- Single supplement: \$2,400.00

#### SERVICES INCLUDED:

- 1 \* Driver and deluxe motor coach with air conditioning daily and a refrigerator with cold water for the group on the house (all accommodation and tour expenses included) per 50 people.
- Entrance fees and activity costs according to itinerary.
- Porterage at each hotel (in and out) where applicable.

For cancellations made between 0 and 60 days before departure, a penalty of \$500 USD will be applied, in addition to any penalties requested by suppliers.

#### ARRIVAL IN JERUSALEM - WELCOME TO ISRAEL




