# <u>Alfalfa</u>

Inoculated Legume, Perennial. Performs best in warm temperatures. Let flowers persist to provide extra pollen source for honey bees.

# **BUCKWHEAT**

Ver

Broadleaf, annual. Best planted late summer. Good for detoxifying soils. Excellent source of pollen for bees, should be tilled before seeds form.

## HAIRY VETCH

Legume, annual. Relative to Fava bean, can be grown alongside desirable crops. Difficult to till in without mowing aggressive vines first. Don't let seed!

## HARDY FAVA BEAN

Legume, annual. Similar to Hairy Vetch but allows a harvest at end of season.

#### <u>Smooth Brome</u>

Grass, annual. Plant early fall, till in spring. Good organic matter source.

WHITE OR RED CLOVER Inoculated Legume, Perennial. "Nitrogen positive", adds free Nitrogen while it grows alongside your vegetables or grass. Also provides flowers for pollinators. Plant in spring or late fall.

#### WINTER RYE

Grass, annual. High-volume organic matter source. Good soil builder.

CRESTED WHEAT Broadleaf, annual. Similar to Winter rye. highly paletable for grazing livestock.
