The Process

- You will be expected to submit an updated résumé.
 - Please ensure your résumé includes any previous arts program you have delivered, any formal training you have had (in any art forms), and any degrees or certifications you have (in any field). Please include the name of the institution(s) or organization(s), nature of program(s), and date of engagement.
- Upon receiving your application, a UCLArts & Healing staff person will follow up with you within three weeks.
