

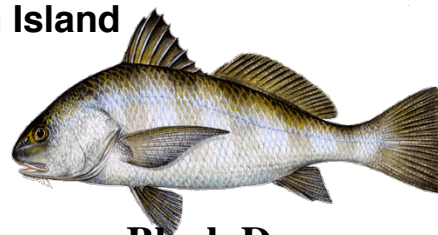

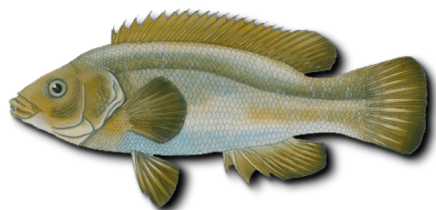

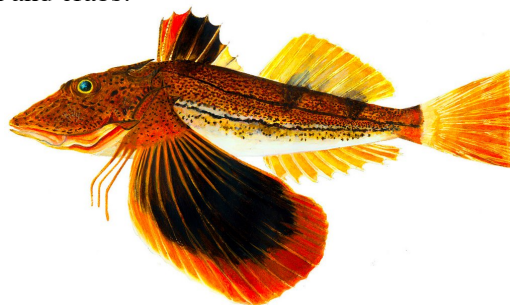
Black Drum

Size Limit-Bag Limit-Season: No Restrictions.
Fair Eating. Black Drum get their common name, by using special muscles, can resonate to produce croaking or drumming sounds. Maximum adult size is 5½ feet long with a weight of 146 pounds. Common baits range from bunker, clam and crabs.



Bergall

Size Limit-Bag Limit-Season: No Restrictions.
Fine eating. A bergall or cunner is a saltwater fish found living on or near structures. Bergalls are pesky bait stealers, and anglers who target them use small hooks. They can be distinguished from the Blackfish by their pointed snouts. Bergalls feed on sandworms, squid, clam or anything else.



Sea Robin

Size Limit-Bag Limit-Season: No Restrictions.
Sea Robins feed on sandworms, squid, clam and will take lures too. Fun to catch and **fine to eat.**



Dogfish

"Depending on who is doing the dining, shark meat tastes like chicken — or roadkill." It's meaty and mild — but has to be soaked well before it's eaten because sharks urinate through their skin. Note: Spiny dogfish have sharp, venomous spines in front of both dorsal fins. Can be caught on almost any bait while fishing using a bottom rig. **Smooth Dogfish or Spiny Dogfish: Size Limit-Bag Limit-Season: No Restrictions.**



Blowfish

Size Limit-Bag Limit-Season: No Restrictions.
Excellent eating!! Blowfish feed on sandworms, squid, and clam. puffs up into a ball in self-defense by inhaling air or water.



Sundials or Windowpane flounder

Size Limit-Bag Limit-Season: No Restrictions.
They are very thin flounders. Its mouth is relatively large with tiny needle-like teeth. They are mostly caught when fishing for fluke or other types of flounder. You can fish for windowpanes with baits of sandworms, squid, or clam. **A tasty fish,** however Younger windowpanes are so thin that they appear transparent.



Triggerfish

Size Limit: None-Bag Limit: No Limit-Season: All Year Triggerfish feed on sandworms, squid, and clam. They have sharp teeth and a tough skin. **Excellent eating.** Triggerfish are found around rocks and inlets.
