
From start to finish, the amount of energy required to create a leather hide is 20 times greater than the production of a synthetic material. To prevent biodegrading, animal hides are treated with over 225 toxic chemicals some of which are lead, cyanide, formaldehyde, benzene and carcinogenic tannins. These chemical create massive pollution to land, water, air supply and are occupational hazards to workers and those in surrounding areas. Exposure to these chemicals are linked to asthma, lung, stomach, bladder, kidney, nasal, and pancreatic cancers, musculoskeletal disorders and leukemia, to name a few.
