

The problem: It doesn't come cheap. Fortunately, for anyone who can't finance pricey slabs of specialty stone, designers of decorative objects, furnishings and tile have jumped on the quarry wagon. "I think this is the best part about Viola skyrocketing in popularity—so many more options," said Ms. Turner. These posh, relatively wallet-friendly pieces include bookends, bath accessories and weighty (yet movable) marble plinths, like those designed by Copenhagen's Norm Architects and sold via the <u>design shop MENU</u>. The low, wide version can act as a coffee table, while a lamp or flower arrangement would sit handsomely atop the chunky pedestal.
