





"When we started out, you'd hire a decorative painter to do limewash," explained Mary Graham of London design firm Salvesen Graham, "but that's

definitely shifting." Ms. Graham, who often works on historic homes with partner Nicole Salvesen, added that the uneven, painterly look—achieved with a large, coarse, natural-bristled brush and applying thin layers in sweeping strokes—can particularly suit older dwellings. As Ms. Salvesen put it, "When you're dealing with a room that has wobbly walls, there's something to be said for leaning into the beauty of irregularity."


