



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

- 1 Cleanse the wound site with a gentle cleanser.
- 2 Apply a ¼" thick layer of TripleHelix Collagen Powder or the appropriate rope or collagen sheet dressing size. Do not pack collagen powder tightly. Collagen sheets and ropes may be trimmed and layered.
- 3 Cover with ExcelSAP[™] or a non-adherent dressing of your choice.

Repeat daily until the wound is healed.

- 3 Place the dressing over the wound, folding any additional material into the wound bed.
- 4 Cover with a secondary dressing of your choice.

Change dressing daily or as directed. Dressings must be changed at least every 7 days. If the wound appears dry, saturate the dressing with sterile saline water prior to removing the dressing.





- 2 Apply the appropriate number of conformable dressings directly onto the wound or use as a secondary dressing. If utilized as a primary dressing, the core edge of the dressing should overlap the wound by a minimum of 2 cm.
- 3 Secure the product in place with bandage or tape, if necessary.

DryMax Extra may be used in combination with compression therapy. Dressing removal can be facilitated by moistening the dressing. Dressing changes can be completed daily, but should be based on the clinical condition of the wound, or before saturation of the wound.
