



How to Find Your Ring Size

FIRST, CONFIRM YOUR PRINTOUT SIZE IS ACCURATE.

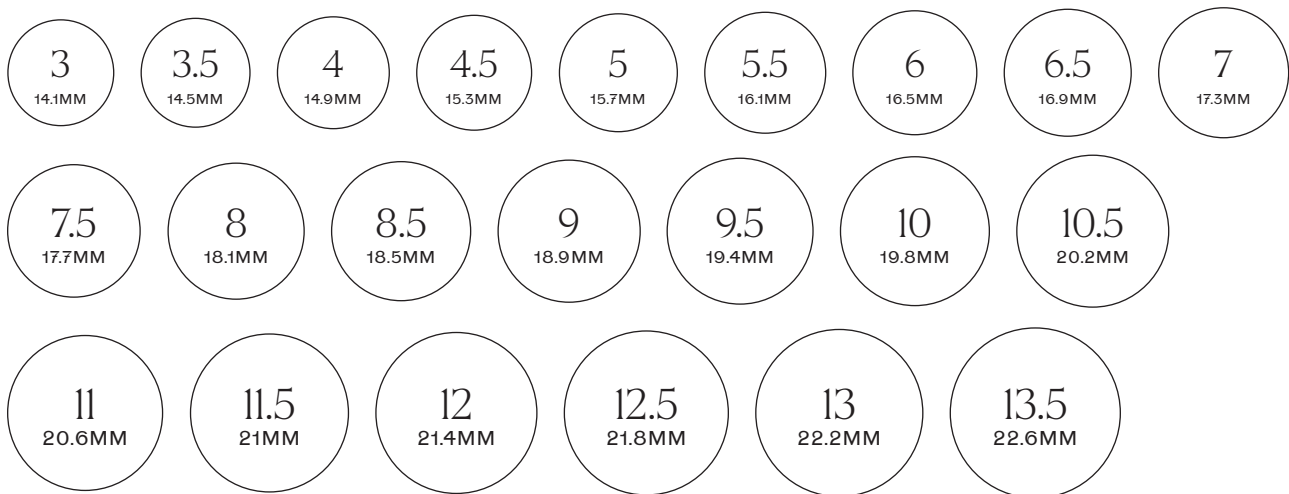
Measure the bar to the right—it should measure exactly 3 inches. If not, check that page scaling is set to “None” in your print dialog box and that you are printing at full size (8.5” x 11”).



Method 1: Measure a Ring That Fits

If you have a ring that fits the finger you’d like to size, place it over the size circles below and match the inside edge of the ring to the drawing. If the ring falls between two sizes, choose the larger size.

How should my ring fit? The right ring should slide on and off your finger easily, with a small twist around the knuckle—not too tight, not too loose.

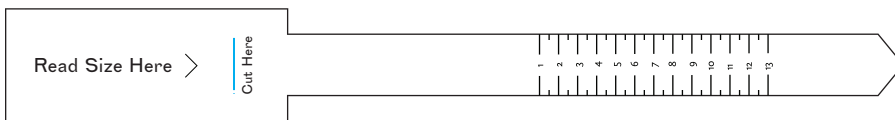

Method 2: Use our Paper Sizing Ruler

Cut out the sizing ruler below and carefully cut a slit on the vertical dashed blue line (“Cut Here”). Wrap the sizing ruler around the base of the intended ring finger. Pull the narrow-angled end through the slit until the paper fits snugly around your finger.
