

Animal Welfare Policy for Knitted Headwear and Accessories

At Do-Gree Fashions Ltd, we take animal welfare seriously and are committed to ensuring that our products do not contribute to animal cruelty or harm. This policy outlines our approach to sourcing down and wool for our knitted headwear and accessories and sets out our commitment to animal welfare.

Sourcing

We are committed to sourcing only high-quality materials from suppliers who share our commitment to animal welfare. Our suppliers must provide evidence that they comply with all relevant animal welfare laws and regulations, and that their practices meet our strict standards.

Down

The down we use in our products must come from birds that have not been subjected to any form of live-plucking or force-feeding. When using down, we only source down from suppliers who can provide us with assurances that the birds have been humanely treated throughout their lives, and that the down has been harvested in a manner that does not cause the birds unnecessary harm.

Wool

The wool we use must come from sheep that have been treated in accordance with the Five Freedoms of Animal Welfare, which are:

- Freedom from hunger and thirst
- Freedom from discomfort
- Freedom from pain, injury, and disease
- Freedom to express normal behavior
- Freedom from fear and distress

We only source wool from certified RWS suppliers who can provide us with assurances that their sheep are treated in accordance with these principles, and that their wool is harvested in a manner that does not cause the sheep unnecessary harm.

Auditing and Monitoring

We regularly audit our suppliers to ensure that they are complying with our animal welfare policy, and we will not hesitate to terminate our relationship with any supplier who fails to meet our standards. We also monitor industry developments and work with animal welfare organizations to stay up-to-date on best practices.
