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SAFETY & PRECAUTIONS

1.PREPARATION

Ensure you have all the necessary tools and components before starting the assembly. A complete parts list is included in this manual. In the event should you find this product has either a defective or a missing part, do not use substitute parts or try to use the unit in an incomplete form. Please contact MEGASTAR for a replacement.

2.INSTALLATION PRECAUTIONS

Assemble the P67 Wall Mounted Power Rack on a flat, stable surface. Avoid soft or uneven flooring to prevent instability. Do not tighten bolts and nuts fully until all components are aligned correctly. Follow the step-by-step instructions carefully. Double-check all connections and ensure bolts, nuts, and washers are securely fastened. The user of this product shall not exceed 400lbs
BEFORE BEGINNING ANY EXERCISE PROGRAM, CONSULT YOUR PHYSICIAN.

3.ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

Inspect the Power Rack monthly for any loose bolts, nuts, or other hardware. Tighten as necessary. Lubricate moving parts as needed (depends on use but once a month is a good rule to follow). Clean the frame with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.

4.PLACEMENT THE BENCH

Store the Power Rack in a dry environment to prevent rust or corrosion. Use rubber floor mats underneath the rack to minimize wear on both the frame and the floor.

5.WARRANTY INFORMATION

The Power Rack is built to last. However, damages caused by natural disasters, accidents, improper use, or modifications are not covered under this warranty. Small components such as bolts, nuts, and washers are covered for 12 months from the date of purchase. To make a replacement, please provide proof of purchase and contact our customer service team. Replacement parts will be shipped free of charge within the warranty period.

6.EXCLUSIONS

This warranty does not cover normal wear and tear, cosmetic damages, or damages resulting from misuse or negligence. Assembly errors that lead to structural instability or damage are not covered.

4. WHEN IT BEGINS?

The Basic Warranty begins from the date of order.

5. WHEN IT ENDS?

The Basic Warranty lasts for 24 months from the date it begins, but the following items are covered only for 12 months: bolts, nuts, washers, foot covers.

6. WHAT'S NOT COVERED?

Please note that while the standard Basic Warranty applies to defects in material and/or workmanship, it does not cover the bench's matte finish appearance.

Maintaining the matte finish appearance is solely the responsibility of the owner.

Basic Warranty doesn't cover damage caused by environmental factors such as airborne fallout, insect damage, chemicals, salt, and ocean spray.

Nor does your warranty cover damage caused by hailstorms, windstorms, tornadoes, sandstorms, lightning, floods, and earthquakes. Your warranty does not cover conditions resulting from anything impacting the bench.
