# PRIOR TO INITIAL USE

First and foremost, please read this user manual. In just 10 minutes, you'll become acquainted with your cool touch tea maker. Afterwards, unpack the components of your tea machine from their packaging.

Underneath the body of your tea maker and the base unit, you will find values indicating the voltage level suitable for use. Please check whether these values are compatible with your main electrical network.

If you notice any damage to any of the parts of your tea maker, please call our live support hotline at **08000 448181** immediately. While inspecting the parts, we kindly request that you pay special attention to the cable.

Once you've confirmed that there are no issues or missing parts in your tea maker, fill it with water up to the maximum level, shake it gently, and pour the water out. Then, boil tap water in the water heater and pour it out. Be careful to use the maximum water level while doing this. Your tea maker is now ready for use.

## HOW TO USE YOUR TEA MACHINE?

Your Royaltea Cool Touch tea maker consists of two main components: the teapot and the kettle. To fill it with water, remove the container from the base unit and add the desired amount of water. Be sure to place water in the tea maker between the "Minimum" and "Maximum" levels.



On the bottom of the container, there is an On/ Off and mode selection buttons.

## The On/Off button is located at the top, indicated by this " () " symbol.

To activate the functions for preparing baby food, brewing herbal tea, or making tea, press the On/Off button first, and then use the "+" and "-" buttons to set your desired temperature.

## The 40°C baby food preparation button

is designated by the "+" and "-" signs.
Select 40°C (you will see 40°C on the temperature display panel, indicating that you have made your selection). When the water temperature reaches 40°C, your tea maker will notify you, saying "Your water is ready, bon appetite to the little one."



### Please be aware:

Even though your machine can bring the water temperature to 40°C, we recommend being cautious and checking the water temperature before preparing baby food.

## The 80°C herbal tea/coffee preparation

**button** is designated by the "+" and "-" signs.
Select 80°C (you will see 80°C on the temperature display panel, indicating that you have made your selection). When the water temperature reaches 80°C, your tea maker will notify you that "your water is ready, enjoy."



## Please be aware:

Your tea maker has a dual safety system that activates when it runs out of water or becomes too hot, automatically shutting off the tea maker.

## **Tea brewing button:**

To brew tea, open the teapot lid, remove the stainless steel tea filter, add the desired amount of tea to the filter, and place it in the teapot.

Select 100°C with the "+" and "-" signs (you will see 100°C on the temperature display panel, indicating that you have made your selection). When the water temperature reaches 100°C, your tea maker will notify you that "your water is ready, enjoy."



### Please be aware:

When the water level under your machine decreases and you add fresh cold water, your machine will automatically start heating according to your selection. You don't need to press any buttons.

### Please be aware:

After pressing the "①" button, don't forget to press the relevant button (40, 80, and 100°C) for your tea maker to function. If you forget, your tea maker won't work.

## WHAT TO CONSIDER WHEN CLEANING YOUR TEA MAKER?

Before you begin cleaning your tea maker, please disconnect the power. First, press the Off button, and then unplug it from the socket. You can wash the filter of your Homend tea maker by hand or in the dishwasher. Do not immerse other parts in water. If necessary, you can wipe them with a dry cloth.

Empty the water in the tea maker's water heater and teapot and wipe the outside with a dry or damp cloth. Do not clean any part of your tea maker with harsh cleaning materials or chemical cleaners

Do not wet the cable or plug of your tea maker.

## WHAT SHOULD YOU DO AGAINST LIMESCALE?

Limescale and sediment will accumulate in the water heater of your tea maker over time. This is a normal occurrence depending on the hardness of the water. You can easily get rid of the sediment and limescale with a simple procedure.

## If the limescale and sediment in your water heater are soft:

Add 100 ml (a little less than half a cup) of vinegar to your water heater along with half a litre of water. Then, run your water heater with the mixture and let it cool. Finally, after letting the mixture sit overnight, shake it thoroughly and pour it out. You will see that the limescale and sediment residues have completely disappeared.

## If the limescale and sediment in your water heater are stubborn:

Add 300 ml (a little more than a cup) of vinegar to your water heater along with half a litre of water. Then, run your water heater with the mixture and let it cool. Finally, after letting the mixture sit overnight, shake it thoroughly and pour it out. To eliminate the vinegar smell, empty the vinegar and rinse your machine 2-3 times with clean water.

## Do not endanger yourself:

After finishing the cleaning process, we recommend ensuring that the electrical connections are dry before using your tea maker. Otherwise, you may cause damage to yourself or your tea maker.

## Your safety is in your hands.

In the following situations, you should unplug the plug from your tea maker:

- Before filling the water
- Before cleaning
- After using your tea maker
- Before emptying the water in your tea maker
- When you leave your tea maker unattended for an extended period

Do not immerse any part of your tea maker (especially the plug, cable, and base unit) in water or any liquid. Before you start using the Homend Royaltea Cool Touch tea maker, please check whether the voltage on the product matches the voltage in your location. In case of any discrepancies, any malfunctions that may occur will not be covered by our company's warranty, and the malfunction will be considered outside the scope of the warranty.

Your tea maker is designed for household use and should not be used for commercial purposes. Keep the tea maker out of the reach of children. Be sure to plug it into a grounded outlet.

Do not use extension cords that provide insufficient current to avoid damaging your machine. Do not place your tea maker directly on or very close to direct heat sources like stoves or hotplates. Place your tea maker on a sturdy and flat surface. Do not place it on the edge of a table or countertop as it may fall with a slight bump, potentially causing harm to you or a child.

Ensure that the cable does not hang over the edge of a table or countertop or come into contact with other devices.

Avoid actions that could damage the cable. When moving, hold the cable but do not use it to carry the tea maker. When unplugging it, hold the plug, not the cable.

Make sure that the tea maker's cable does not touch sharp edges, corners, or hot surfaces.

If your tea maker is damaged for any reason, do not use it and contact customer service.

Only use your Royaltea tea maker with its own base unit. Do not use it with the base unit of other devices.

Protect your hands from the steam when the water is boiling.

Never allow small children, physically or mentally disabled individuals to use the tea maker without your supervision and control.

When there is no water in your tea maker or when it is not in use, the plug must be removed from the socket.

Do not immerse your tea maker, its cable, or base unit in water or any liquid. Do not wash it in a dishwasher. Do not use it in bathrooms or places with high humidity. Be careful not to place your tea maker on the base unit when adding water.

Please use only water in your water heater; do not use any other liquid.

Ensure that your tea maker's base unit and electrical terminals are not wet. If they are wet, do not plug the plug into the socket or operate the device without thoroughly drying it.

Before cleaning the device, turn off the on/ off switch, unplug it from the socket, and wait for the device to cool down.

### Please be aware:

When emptying the boiling water from the water heater, do so slowly rather than in a hurry. Rapidly emptying boiling water can cause splashes and lead to burns, especially on your hands and arms.

If you encounter any issues with your tea maker's operation, please contact us at our live phone line at **08000 448181** to inform us. Do not attempt to repair any problem yourself, no matter how small it may seem, as it may lead to more significant issues.

If you notice that any part of your tea maker, especially the power cord, has been damaged, please refrain from using your water heater.

This situation can pose serious life-threatening risks, especially in products that consume high amounts of electricity, such as tea makers. Never allow small children or individuals with physical or mental disabilities to use the tea maker without your supervision and control.

## Tips:

It is normal for water droplets to accumulate under the teapot. We recommend that you serve by sliding the base onto the body when removing it.

If you want your tea to stay fresh for a long time, remove the filter with the tea granules from the teapot after brewing. Brewed tea remains fresh for hours

After putting tea in the filter, pass cold water through the tea and then place the filter in the teapot. This way, you remove any dust or particles from the tea.

If you use the sterilising mode and want your water to cool more quickly after boiling, we recommend keeping the lid open while waiting. For your reference, you can find the approximate waiting times in the two scenarios below.

## First, boiling, and then 40°C cooling time:

With the lid open, approximately 1 hour 10 minutes.

With the lid closed, approximately 2 hours 10 minutes.

## First, boiling, and then 80°C cooling time:


With the lid open, approximately 35 minutes.

With the lid closed, approximately 55 minutes.

## To connect your Royaltea Cool Touch Tea Maker with the Homend Smart Application, follow the steps below:




Step 1: Download the

Google Play.




**Step 2:** Register in the application and enter the verification code sent to you via email.

**Step 3:** Create a password for your application account.







Step 5: Select your Cool Touch tea maker from the relevant tab. Enable the Bluetooth and location functions on your mobile device. Your Cool Touch tea maker will use the Bluetooth connection, whenever possible, to perform the setup process and connect to your mobile device.



**Step 6:** Unplug your device. Plug your device back in after 10 seconds. Click on the next option.







Step 7: While your Cool Touch kettle is turned on, press and hold on the digital display of your Cool the "+-" button for 5 seconds. After holding it for 5 seconds, click on the next option.

Step 8: Check if the green light








**Step 9:** Check the name of the Wi-Fi network your phone is connected to, enter the password Touch kettle. for your Wi-Fi network, and click


on the next option.
