In Production: Heirloom Tables for Dan White

Read on for the story of the plank, told by Dan. Pictured alongside, you can see Dan's wife Barbara holding the plank in Wolf Creek, Montana, about 25 years ago.

She intended on turning the plank into a table and passing it down to members of the family. Following the passing of



her parents, Barbara shipped some of their belongings, including the plank, to their home in Delaware. When Barbara passed two years ago, Dan sold their Delaware home and moved to Portland, Oregon to be near their daughter and the grandchildren — and he brought the plank with him.

"That good old piece of wood traveled cross country two times," says Dan. Following the move to Portland, Lauren discovered Tree to Table PDX and decided that we would be the right people to transform the plank into a piece of furniture that can stay in the family for generations. Eventually, Dan tells us, the tables will be gifted to the grandchildren. Dan continues to say "Barbara's wish will finally come true to remind our future generations of the connection to the Montana family heritage."
