



Assembly Instruction

Installation of Wall Mount Arm

Refore Installation

1. Wall

The wall must be strong enough to support the arm assembly.

2. Height

The recommended height of the wall bracket is 1840/1950mm from the floor to the bottom of the bracket (see diagram)

3. Electric Source


An electrical power outlet must be prepared on the wall within 500mm distance from the wall bracket.


Installation of Wall Plate & Wall Bracket


- 1. The wall plate and wall bracket are already attached together with bolts upon delivery. (See diagram)
- 2. With the supplied spanner, loosen the bolts and remove the wall plate
- 3. Use the wall plate as a template and drill three holes on the wall (please refer to diagram for the correct drill positioning). The size and depth of the holes will be in accordance with the bolts supplied.
- 4. Attach the wall bracket to the wall with the bolts, and then fix with the supplied washers.
- 5. Attach the wall bracket to the wall plate, and then tighten with bolts


Caution! As the wall plate and wall bracket are subject to a large load, please make sure that the wall plate is installed correctly and securely.

Do not remove stopper on arm until the machine head is correctly installed. The arm assembly is spring loaded and could cause damage to equipment and customers if not handled correctly.










Arm Assembly & Machine Head

The machine head and the arms are fairly heavy, it is suggested that the installation is done by two persons, as instructed in the following steps.

- 1 Remove the screw on the protector plate and rotate the protector plate anti-clockwise until it is vertical. Remove the hook lock after loosening the screw.
- 2 Stand the machine with head facing floor and keep upright with two hands. Another person will need to insert the tip of the arm into the machine head.
- 3 Reinstall the hook lock to the grove and then tighten the groove screw firmly.
- 4 Turn the protector plate clockwise back to its original position and then tighten the screw at the protector plate either side.
- 5 Separately, two persons hold up the machine head and the arm assembly at the same time. Place the arm assembly to the insert of the wall bracket.
- 6 Remove the stopper and fix it in an opposite way for future spare use. Only after the installation is complete will you be able to move the arm assembly up/down, or it will damage the arms.
- 7 Connect the power cable into the wall socket.




Adjustment of Arm Assembly

Wall Bracket

- 1 After finishing the installation, hold the machine body with two hands and move up and down to adjust the height position as you require. Please operate with care avoiding ceilings, furniture etc. In order to protect the arms, it is suggested not to remove the cover off the arms and not to rotate the adjusting bolt.
- 2 Before the manufacturer delivers the product the strength of the arm spring has been adjusted. Please load the correct weight as shown on the arm assembly.



Control Panel

Start/Stop

Press this key to start or end treatments. When the machine is on the control panel will illuminate, when the machine/treatment stops the control panel will not illuminate.

Fan(Anion)

Push this key to start/stop the fan. By pressing once the treatment will begin at a weak level, press twice for middle level, three times for strong level and by pressing four times the treatment will end; although the fan will still circulate.

The control panel will illuminate if the fan is in operation, once the treatment has come to an end the control panel will not light.

Swing Key

Push this key to stop the arms swinging refraining from any movement, by pressing this key twice the arms will resume movement. The control panel will illuminate when the arms are in operation, when the arms are no longer in use the panel will not light.

Selecting Mode Key

By pressing this key this machine enables you to choose from one of the six built in modes, listed below...

A. Perm B. Colouring 1 C. Colouring 2	D. Treatment E	E. Dry F. Manual
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The control panel will illuminate the mode selected.

Temperature Keys

- Press \triangle to increase the temperature by 1 level.
- Press ∇ to decrease the temperature by 1 level.

The temperature selected will illuminate on the control panel.

Time Setting Keys

- Press \triangle to increase the time by 1 minute, hold the key to increase time up to 60 minutes.
- Press ∇ to decrease the temperature by 1 level, hold the key to decrease time down to 1 minute.

The temperature selected will illuminate on the control panel.


Digital Indicator

The indicator will show the time remaining on the current treatment. When the treatment has come to an end the control panel will show as "00" and will continue to show extra time.



To get the best results out of this product and to ensure customers comfort, please follow the steps listed below...




Step 1
Alida should be adjusted and placed 6-8cm from the back of the customer s head and 5cm (2") from the rear of the customer's neck.




Step 2
The distances between A and B should be exact. (As in diagram)

Caution & Maintenance

- 1. Avoid use in extreme hot or cold temperatures.
- 2. Please use correct power source



3. Do not disconnect the power plug by pulling the cable. Hold the plug and then pull.



5. Do not touch during operation – Hot Surfaces.



4. Dry hands before use.



6. Do not move or lift product when in use. This could damage the machine as well as causing damage to customer/stylist.

Operation Manual

Note: Please read the information regarding suitable positioning, before operating.

Turn on Machine

- 1. Turn on the power switch, the LED light will glow.
- 2. The control panels default is set to "Manual"

Select a Mode

- 1. Select "Choose Mode" and select the treatment required.
- 2. Temperature level, time and fan can be adjusted according to treatment.

Start/Stop

- 1. The machine will start to heat as per the selected working mode, during this time the LED control panel will glow.
- 2. The LED will continue to glow until the machine stops.
- 3. The arms will start movement and heating

During Operation

- 1. The start/stop, temperature and time indicators LED will continue to light during operation.
- 2. During the working mode you may alter the time and temperature by using the time/temp buttons.

Changing Current Mode

- 1. Push the "start/stop" key to interrupt the treatment. The arms and indicator light will enter standby mode.
- 2. The modes and temperature levels will shine after you have reselected a new programme.
- 3. Time light will be off and the indicator will show the preliminary set time.
- 4. Select the new mode you wish to switch to then select the "start/stop" key. The machine will now resume with the new selected mode.

Finish Treatment

- 1. The control panel will sound when the treatment has come to an end.
- 2. The arms will automatically move back to the default position and stop heating.
- 3. Start/Stop and Indicator light will turn off.
- 4. The modes and temperature levels will glow.
- 5. The digital time indicator will show as "0" when the machine has finished operation. The time light will then flash once per second to start counting down any extra time.

Turn Off Power Source

- 1. Turn off machine by the power switch.
- 2. Please pull out the power plug, if machine is not in use for a long period of time

Note: During operation, the fan can be turned on/off at your will. The machine can resume to original position when the set time is up. The control panel will sound and the time will indicate as "00" and begin to re-calculate the time.
