## HOW TO START A BREED UP PROGRAM

- **STEP 1)** Become an AKHA member Membership allows you access to AKHA products and services. In the members only section and AKHA members only Facebook page.
- **STEP 2)** Choose a Foundation ewe Choose a breed that has similar traits that of a Kerry Hill Sheep, suggested list of breeds on the Foundation Ewe form (see forms)
- STEP 3) Purchase 100% imported Kerry Hill Sheep frozen semen straws from a reputable importer, OR a private owner of semen straws that supplies the DNA of the imported sire. Beware of anyone charging extra for frozen semen straws for DNA of behalf of AKHA. AKHA does not approve of a company charging AKHA members for DNA. (See frozen semen form)
- **STEP 4)** Schedule a Laparoscopic Artificial Insemination specialists (LAI). Most sheep breed August December. "Know the breeding season of your Foundation ewe."
- **STEP 5)** Get lambs DNA banked at, <a href="www.flock54.com">www.flock54.com</a>. Contact them for the supplies needed. This will allow you to know your flock genetic traits, diseases and parentage verification of recorded imported sires.
- **STEP 6)** Register the foundation ewe and ewe lambs. No need to register ram lambs unless F3=(87.5%), if you choose to do so. (See guidelines)
- **STEP 7)** LAI ewe progeny with another 100% Imported Kerry Hill Semen.

Repeat steps 2 through 7 until you reach F5=96.87% "American Purebred"

## **Calculating Percentages for Progeny (Lambs)**

% Of ewe + % of ram = \_\_\_\_\_% / 2 = progeny (lamb) %

Example: a (F1) ewe 50% + 100% imported semen = 150% / 2 = (F2) 75% [progeny)
