

Singlespeed Hub Instructions

Thank you for purchasing a Dimension singlespeed disccompatible hub. The hub features a high-flange design, four sealed cartridge bearings, and can be used with a quickrelease or the included axle bolts. The freehub accepts all Shimano-compatible splined cogs. The disc mount is designed for ISO 6-bolt rotors.

WARNING:

Read these instructions completely BEFORE beginning installation of this product. If you lack the knowledge or tools to perform the installation, please have your local professional bicycle mechanic perform the installation. Improper installation can result in loss of control or damage to the bicycle and/or serious injury or death to the rider. We STRONGLY recommend installation of this product be performed by a professional bicycle mechanic.

WARNING:

The rear hub is designed for use with a Shimano spline-compatible cog and the included lockring. Neglecting to use the included lockring and proper cog can result in loss of control or damage to the bicycle and/or serious injury or death to the rider.

Included Parts

- One (1) hub
- Two (2) steel axle bolts and washers
- Two (2) serrated cup washers
- One (1) lockring
- Two (2) 3mm cog spacers

Required Tools for Installation

The following tools are required to properly adjust and install the hub into your bicycle:

- · Bicycle grease
- · Lockring spanner
- 17mm cone wrench
- Two (2) 19mm wrenches
- Torque wrench with 5mm Allen key (if using included axle bolts)

BUILDING INTO A WHEEL

CAUTION: DIMENSION SINGLESPEED HUBS ARE NOT DESIGNED TO BE LACED RADIALLY. HUBS THAT ARE BUILT WITH RADIAL LACING WILL NOT BE COVERED BY WARRANTY.

It is recommended that the hubs be built into a wheel using a 3-cross lacing pattern.

ADJUSTMENT & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Make sure the cones and locknuts are secure. Using the 17mm cone wrench and 19mm wrench, tighten the non-driveside cone and locknut against each other. Using the two 19mm wrenches, tighten the outer locknuts against each other. The bearings should spin freely but without side-to-side play.
- Install your cog and desired cassette spacers onto the freehub. Hand tighten the lockring onto the freehub. Install the hub into the frame and check the chainline.

Note: The front sprocket should directly align with the rear cog. If not, the cog will need to be moved on the freehub. Rearrange the cog and spacers so that the chainring aligns with the cog.

Note: You may need to use additional and/or smaller spacers than those provided with the hub.

To ensure proper lockring engagement with the cog and spacers, the combined width of the cog and spacers should be at least 7mm and less than 13mm.

- When the cog has been properly located on the hub, apply grease to the lockring thread and thread onto the freehub. Use a lockring spanner to fully tighten the lockring.
- 4. If using a disc rotor, install it on the hub following the disc rotor manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. If the hub is to be used on a bicycle with horizontal dropouts, we recommend using the included axle bolts and washers. Quick-release skewers don't provide as much clamping force as the bolts, and may allow the hub to slip in the dropouts.
- 6. Install the wheel into the bicycle. If using horizontal drops, pull the hub back in the frame to tension the chain properly. If using included Allen bolts, apply grease to the threads. Place the washer on the bolt and then the serrated cup washer (with serrations facing toward the frame). Using the torque wrench, tighten the bolts to 110–130 in lb (12.5–14.5 Nm). If using a quick-release skewer, tighten according to manufacturer's instructions.
