TIMBER RATTLESNAKE

- 2 oz Tom Cat Gin
- 1 oz Fresh Lemon Juice
- 0.75 oz Raw Honey Syrup
- ½ tsp Absinthe
- 1 Egg White

A variation on the classic 'Rattlesnake' cocktail from © 1920 by Ada Coleman and/or Harry Craddock at the Savoy Hotel in London where they were known to say "this cocktail will either cure a rattlesnake bite, kill a rattlesnake, or make you see them!"

A Timber Rattlesnake is an endangered species and the only poisonous snake found in Vermont.

Dry shake. Shake again with ice. Double strain into a coupe glass. Garnish with Angostura Bitters and a spritz of absinthe.
