Platinum

A naturally white metal; Platinum is purer than all other metals and is dense in weight, retaining the feeling of substance and superiority. As white hue is a permanent colour, it requires no maintenance and the colour will never change.

Platinum is the hardest precious metal and is sturdy and scratch resistant, which is also hypoallergenic and more durable than any other metal. Platinum has more recently risen to be the preferred choice for wedding rings and high-quality jewellery with its strength to last within its perfection - for a lifetime.

Platinum 600

Titanium

Titanium is a metal that is tough and resilient yet highly affordable. A darker silver grey metal that is extremely strong and durable without the added weight.

Titanium is also hypoallergenic making a good metal choice for those with sensitive skin. Titanium is lightweight, very resistant to damage, as it does not bend.

You cannot resize Titanium due to its sheer strength.

Zirconium

Zirconium is naturally a grey colour metal, similar to the colour of titanium. Once the metal is heat treated, the exposed section is oxidised black, overtime this black appearance when scratched will show the natural grey colour of the metal.

Zirconium cannot be resized, nor can engraving be removed from this metal (Zirconium can be engraved) Zirconium is lightweight, durable and hypoallergenic Zirconium rings are covered under our Forever Fit Guarantee.

Carbon Fibre

Carbon fibre rings are light weight Carbon rings are strong, durable and hypoallergenic. Carbon fibre cannot be re sized.

A ring made from carbon fibre can be engraved, once engraving is done, it cannot be removed Carbon fibre has a weaved texture and generally feels cool to touch, it doesn't conduct heat The surface does/can scratch.

Carbon Fibre rings are covered under our Forever Fit Guarantee.

Tantalum

Tantalum is a dense earth metal with great malleability and a beautiful lustre.

With a comparable weight to platinum, tantalum feels luxurious and is known for its durability.

Tantalum is a strong and durable metal and is preferred for its low maintenance characteristics.

Like most metals, Tantalum will show natural wear over time, adding to the appeal of this beautiful dark metal. It can be refinished and does not require any plating.
