

# Suggestions For Installing Your New Range Bags to a Zuca Transit Cart

Thank you for purchasing one of our new Pistol Range Bag sets for the Zuca Transit cart. Following these suggestions will make installing the bags into the cart easier.

#### Step 1

Remove the Transit cart bag from the frame. You will NOT need to remove the beverage holders to install our bags.

### Step 2

Start with the lower bag. There is a stripe of adhesive backed loop Velcro tucked inside a pocket in the range bag. This strip of Velcro is applied to the bottom of the carts lower tray along the front edge. This adhesive is VERY STICKY and once it contacts a surface it is difficult to remove. Peel back only 2 inches of backing and starting in a corner line the stripe up with the front edge of the cart. It is not necessary to be tight to the front edge or perfectly straight. Peel more backing as you progress across the front of the cart until the full length of the stripe is applied to the cart. Once installed apply moderate pressure along the full length of the stipe to fully activate the adhesive.

## Step 3

Un-zip the lower bag and line the hook Velcro sewn on the bottom of the bag with the stripe you just applied and press the hooks and loops together. You will find a pair of double-sided Velcro stripes in each top corner of the bag. Wrap these around the horizontal side bars of the cart and press together. The lower bag is now complete.

# Step 4

Wrap the loose tail of the rig hanger strap around the front upper horizontal bar with the plastic loop on the bottom and thread webbing through the loop and thread male buckle on webbing. To place rig in hanger release buckle, wrap around rig and close buckle. Tighten strap as desired.

### Step 5

With the top range bag unzipped and the cart seat flipped fully up push the bag into the top of the cart until it rests on the cross bars. The front mag pocket will need to be pulled under the front cross bar and pulled forward. There are three pairs of double-sided Velcro on each side of the bag. Wrap these around the bars of the cart and press together.

You are now ready to load your gear into the bags and go to the range. Enjoy!
