



Measurement Guide

Please use the below information for taking measurements for your custom made Matchimony Bridesmaid dresses. Please fill in one new form for each bridesmaid that you are measuring for. Please note that items take 6-8 weeks for creation and delivery and are non-returnable as they are custom-made to the individual. There is also a £40 made to measure charge per dress. You will require: one full length measuring tape and one stiff retractable tape measure for length.

Measurement	How to Measure	Your size (please write in here your detailed sizes in Centimetres)
Length 1	Stand up straight against a wall so you have a fully straight posture and have a friend extend the retractable tape measure from the top of your shoulders (at the highest point where they meet your neck, not where the straps would go) to the full length of dress that you would require (kneelength or floor length). Please ensure you are wearing the correct footwear and your head is held high.	
Length 2	Do the same as above but measure from the hollow of the collarbone (at the very base of the throat) to the full length of dress that you would require (kneelength or floor length), there should be approximately 5-8cm difference in length 1 and length2.	
Chest	Wrap the soft measuring tape around your chest area, approximately 2 inches down from your armpit and above the full part of your bust. Ensure the tape is not gaping between your shoulder blades and instead is flush against your back.	
Bust	Wrap the soft measuring tape around the fullest part of the bust, allow a snug fit but also allow breathing room. Ensure the tape is flat against your shoulder blades and flush against your back. Please measure whilst wearing the underwear you intend to wear on the day (our dresses include padded cups so a bra may not be needed for all bust sizes.)	
Under Bust	Wrap the soft measuring tape around the ribcage right under the bust line, Ensure the tape is flat against your shoulder blades and flush against your back, this ensures a better fit for the ribcage to accommodate the boning of our strapless and multiway dresses	
Waist	Wrap the soft measuring tape around the narrowest part of your waist. Shift around slightly to ensure it is not a tight fit and can accommodate movement.	
Hips	Wrap the soft measuring tape around the widest part of your hips, this point is usually 7" to 9" below the natural waistline.
