

# Vellum Placement Guides & Instructions

## STANDARD SIZE

1. Place your tabs in order per the list below. It's very easy to skip over smaller books of the Bible.
2. Select which design fits your Bible best, paying attention to spacing at the top and bottom of your Bible page.
3. Cut along the dotted line to remove excess paper. This will make the placement process more manageable. Consider cutting away the guides you are not using to avoid confusion.
4. Keep in mind these tabs are not double sided. Therefore, in order to read the tabs appropriately, lay each tab on the right page of your Bible even if the individual book starts on the left page.
5. Let's begin: open to Genesis. Lay the placement guide under the right page aligning the edge of the Bible page with the solid vertical line.
6. Peel the self-adhesive backing off your tab. Gently lay it down, aligning the part of the tab that hangs off the page with the grey, shaded tab on the guide.
7. Close your Bible to ensure you like the placement. Remove and reapply if necessary. Once pleased, secure the tab by firmly pressing it down. Attempting to remove the tab will now rip the page.
8. Repeat steps 5, 6, & 7 with the remainder of the tabs.
