

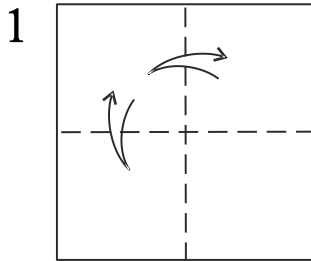


Origami Furniture You Can Make at Home

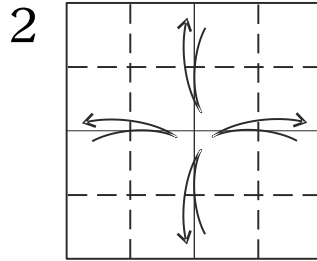

Behold! Instructions to make your very own origami furniture, courtesy of your friends at ZZ Driggs. We promise it's not too hard!

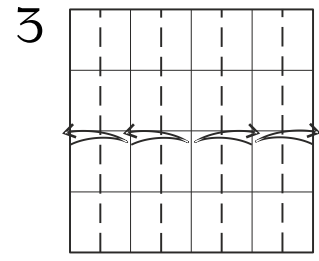
Start by cutting out the square (next page), and begin the folding process with the colored side down. Pro tip: dotted lines are new folds, straight lines are existing folds.



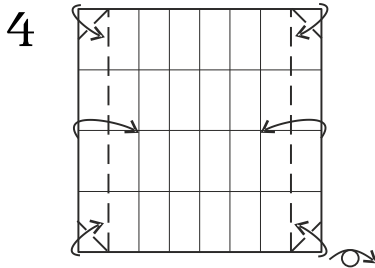
1 Fold and unfold the square in half lengthwise along both axes.



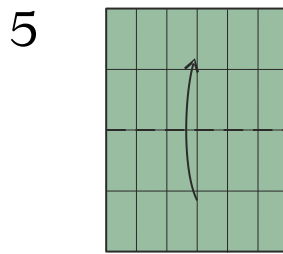
2 Fold and unfold the outer and upper edges to the middle.



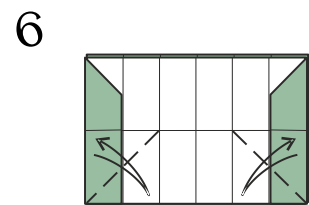
3 Fold and unfold between the creases folded previously.



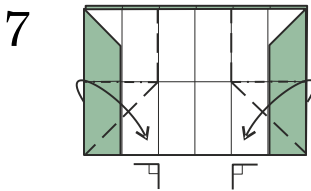
4 Fold the corners in. Then fold in the edges. Turn the model over.



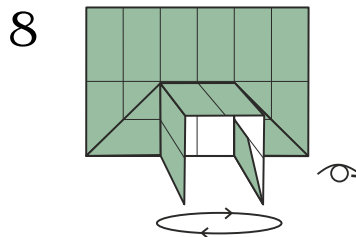
5 Fold the edge up to touch the other side.



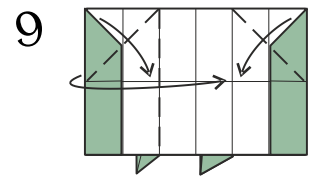
6 Fold and unfold each side of the upper layer diagonally to create two creases as shown.



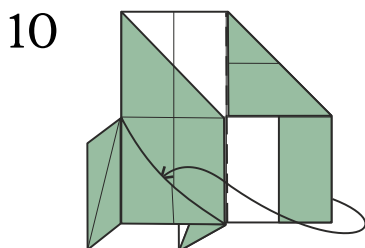
7 Now fold both sides of the top layer down, causing the "seat" of the chair to stick out perpendicular to the back.



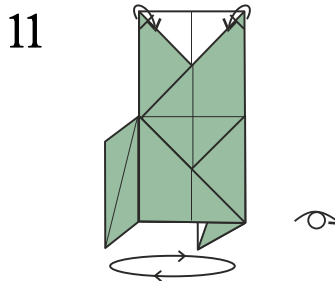
8 Rotate the model to work on the reverse side.



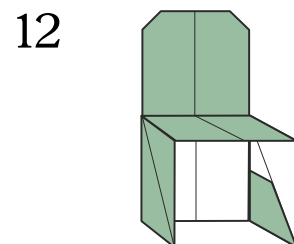
9 Fold the corners down. Then fold one edge in.



10 Fold the other side over. Tuck the lower corners into the pocket on the other side.



11 Fold the corners over. Then rotate the model.



12 Et voilà!

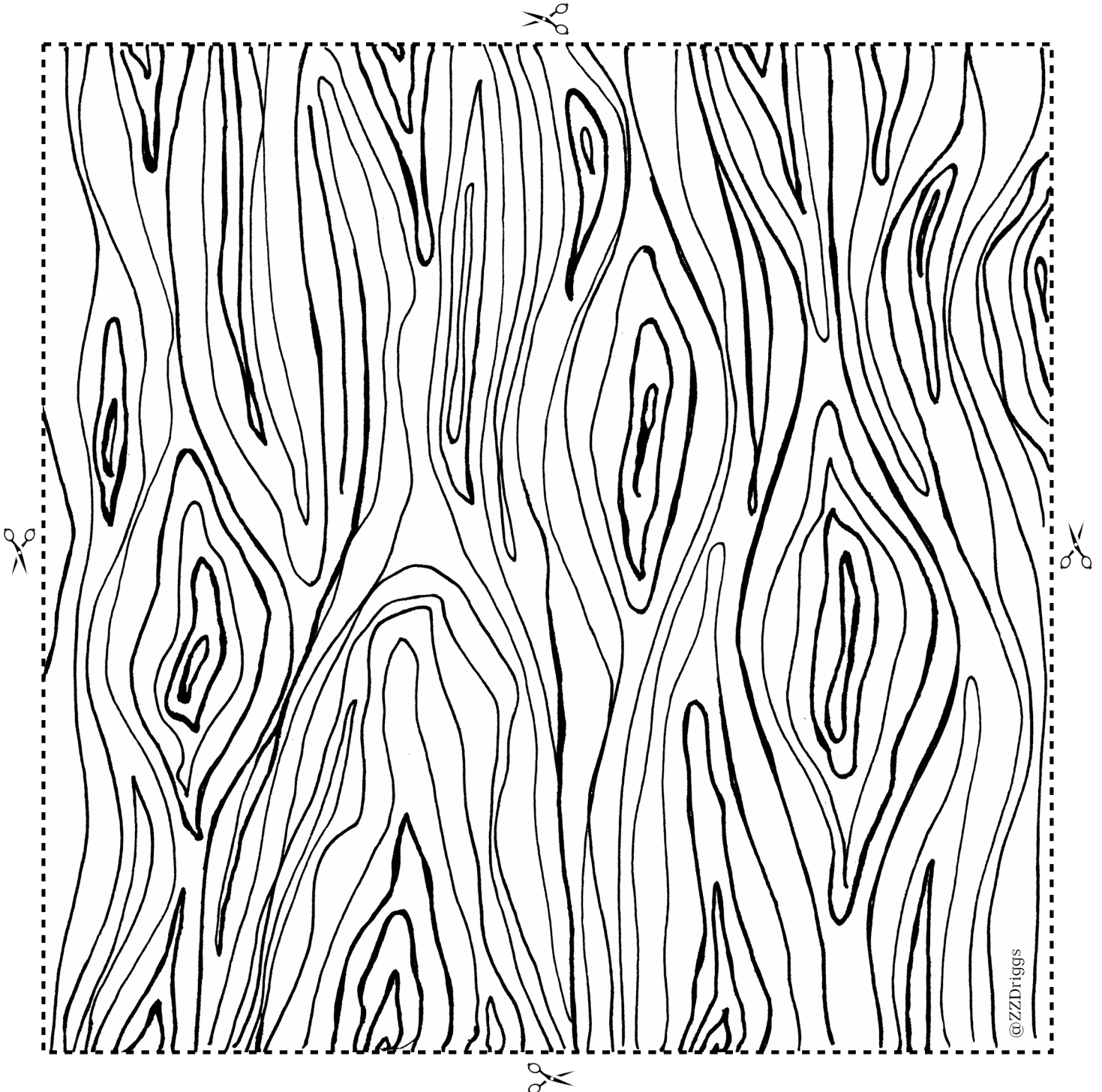
