PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This programmable automatic pet feeder can be easily customized to suit you and your pet's needs, whether you are at home or not. It can be programmed using an integrated LCD control panel to accommodate a 24-hour period, automatically dispensing convenient, portion-controlled meals for your pets up to 8 times a day.

Dry and solid pet food only, recommended food diameter between 5 to 10mm.





(actual size of compatible feed)

4 BATTERY INSTALLATION

Always use 3 good quality 1.5V alkaline D cell batteries. This will ensure the best performance of your automatic pet feeder. This product is not designed for use with rechargeable batteries.

- 1. Please turn off the device before you change the battery.
- 2. Use the screwdriver to open the battery compartment.
- 3. Insert 3 x D batteries. Ensure the +/- symbols on the batteries match the symbols on the unit itself.
- 4. Put the battery cover back and tighten the screws.

5 POWER SWITCH

- When ON, O When OFF.

6 USB POWER INLET

A USB cable is provided inside the package. Please choose a 5Vdc 1.0A power source.

7 PRODUCT ASSEMBLY

Attention: all assembly parts must be locked into position before use.


- Locking the lid to the food barrel: Place the lip on the top of the barrel and push it down to lock it into position.
- Installing the bowl to the base: Insert pins of the bowl into two pillars beneath the base. Press down to lock the bowl.




8.1 PROGRAMMING OPERATION

A. Local time setting, number of daily meals selective.


Turn on the device first, then press the <u>SET</u> button (Step 1), and HOUR will flash. Set the current hour by pressing the <u>UP</u> button (Step 2). Please press <u>OK</u> to confirm (Step 3).



Further, the MINUTE will flash. Press the <u>UP</u> button (Step 4) until the correct minute is selected. Then press <u>OK</u> to confirm (Step 5).



After the time is set, then the MEALS will flash. Press the <u>UP</u> button (Step 6) to select the number of meals to serve per day. If "6" is chosen, it means there will be 6 meals served per day. You may select up to 8 meals per day. After you select the desired number of meals to be served per day, press <u>OK</u> (Step 7) to confirm.





8.2 PROGRAMMING OPERATION

B. Set the feeding time and the portion of each meal

Note: you may select up to 15 portions. 1 portion is about 15g of dry food. Example: you select 3 meals per day, 8 portions for each meal.

B1. Setting the first meal:

After setting the desired number of meals to 3 and pressing OK, "A-1" will show. Then setting the feeding time for the first meal (Please refer to part A). After finishing the time setting, the PORTION will flash, select the number of the portion you want by pressing the UP button. Then press OK to confirm. In this example, we press the UP button 8 times and press the OK button.



B2. Setting the second meal:

After setting the first meal, "A-2" will show. Please repeat the steps in B1, then press OK to confirm.





8.3 PROGRAMMING OPERATION

B3. Setting the third meal:

After setting the second meal, "A-3" will show. Please repeat the steps in B1, then press OK to confirm. Now the LCD screen stops flashing, and the feeding schedule is setting successfully. The program is back to Normal mode.




C. Manual feeding

You can also operate the device manually. Simply just press the OK button in normal mode and the pet feeder will release one portion of food for one button press.

D. Total portion calculation

As you can see "TOTAL" section is shown on the LCD screen. It records the total number of meals this pet feeder has served from start.



9 RATTERY REPLACEMENT

- When the LCD screen becomes vague, the batteries need to be changed
- Repeat the above Battery installation part to replace all new fresh batteries.

Note: your programming information is stored and will not be lost when you switch off or replace batteries. But you need to reset the current time once your product is powered up.



APPENDIX A -SAFETY LOCK INSTALLATION

Large, persistent or excited pets may be able to access the hopper. To prevent unintentional feed access it is recommended to use the safety locks (provided). Excessive food consumption may be harmful to your pet. Install as per the installation instructions below. Replace the adhesive should the safety locks show signs of failing adhesive over time. Make sure to secure the safety locks after refilling the hopper.

Peel the adhesive backing off the safety locks and apply them to either side of the hopper, ensure the hooks firmly secure the lid as shown below.



CAUTIONS

- Do not mix any old or new battery types, replace all the batteries at the same time.
- Please use alkaline-type batteries only. Do not use any rechargeable batteries for this product.
- Observe the correct polarities as marked when inserting the batteries. Do not short-circuit the power supply terminal.
- Remove batteries when not in use. Recycle or dispose of exhausted batteries according to federal, state, and local laws. Do not dispose of batteries in a fire, as may leak or explode.
- It's not a toy, keep it out of reach of small children.
- Hand clean with a slightly damp doth. Do not soak or submerge the product in water.
- Remove all tags and packaging before using this product.
- Inspect the product every time before use. Immediately discontinue use, and discard if any
 parts of this product are broken or contain any sharp edges.
- · Do not insert fingers, tools, or any other objects into the hopper.
- Always supervise your pet and monitor its chewing habits. Do not allow your pet to swallow, damage, chewing any parts of this product.
- Always keep away from open flames or other heat sources to avoid fire risks.
- Your pet's health and safety are your responsibility, please take care of your pet.



WARRANTY
