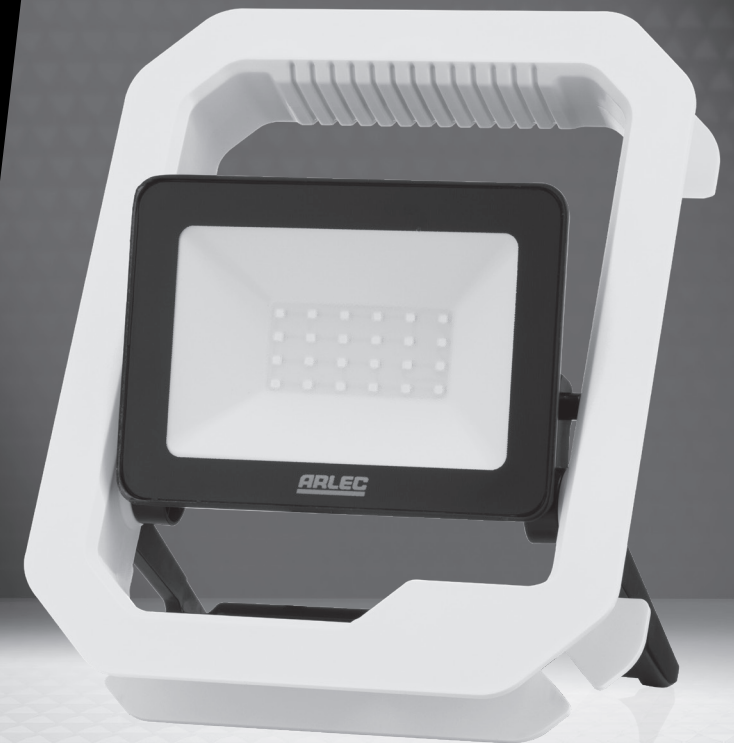

Warning

DO NOT immerse in water or any other liquid.

While using outdoors the supply plug and socket-outlet must be suitably protected against water ingress.

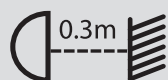
Discard the product if the supply flexible cord is damaged.

Use of Worklight

1. Unfold and adjust the stand to desired position. A lower angle will provide more stability to the worklight.
2. Adjust the tilt of the lamp head by pushing the lamp body forward or backward to the desired angle while holding the base stand firmly in position. You may need to loosen and retighten the knobs that fix the frame to the bracket.
3. Plug the worklight into a power point. Ensure the cable is fully uncoiled.
4. Turn ON the power to the worklight.

Arlec will (or authorise the retailer to) assess any claim you may make on the Warranty in the above manner and if, in Arlec's reasonable opinion, the Warranty applies, Arlec will at its own option and expense (or authorise the retailer to) replace the

product with the same or similar product or repair the product and return it to you or refund the price you paid for the product. Arlec will bear its own expenses of doing those things, and you must bear any other expenses of claiming on the Warranty.
