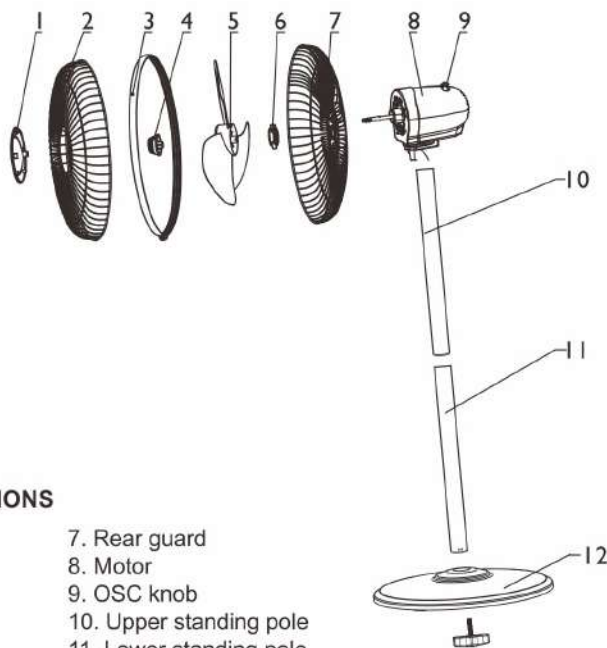
Please read this instruction carefully. It is advisable to keep this instruction manual in a safe place for future reference.

- Always disconnect the fan when moving it from one location to another.

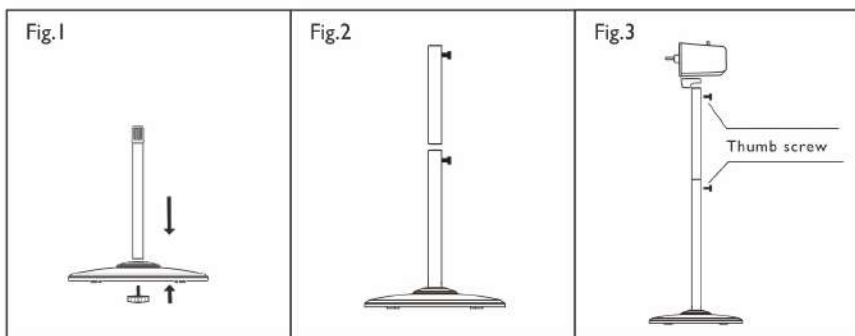

| 6. Guard knob | 12. Base & Screw |

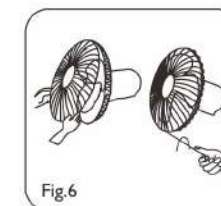
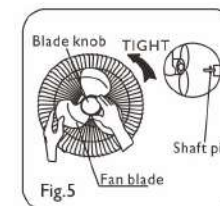
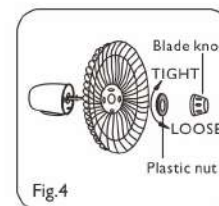
STANDING POLE AND FAN BODY ASSEMBLY

1. Open the gift box and check the parts by referring to the product description drawing.
2. Insert the lower standing pole into the base and fasten the base screw. (Fig. 1)
3. Loosen the thumb screws on the lower standing pole and insert the upper pole into it. (Fig. 2)
4. Put the fan head into the upper standing pole and fasten the thumb screw on the back. (Fig. 3)



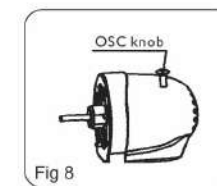
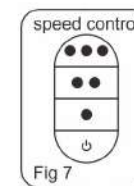
FAN BLADE AND GUARDS ASSEMBLY

1. Remove the blade & guard nut from the motor shaft. Fix the rear guard to the front motor cover, then fasten the guard nut again. (Fig 4)
2. Fix the fan blade to the motor shaft and make sure the shaft pin is fit into groove of the blade. Turn the knob counter-clockwise to fasten the blade. (Fig 5)
3. Fix both fan guards with the guard ring and use a screwdriver to lock the screw. (Fig 6)



OPERATING INSTRUCTION

1. Speed is controlled by the press button on back of the rear motor cover. The 4 buttons represents "on/off, Low, Mid, High" functions. (Fig.7)
2. To make/stop the fan head oscillate. Press or pull up the OSC knob to control the fan oscillation (Fig.8)
3. The airflow can be adjusted upward or down-ward by pushing or pulling the lower part of the fan guard.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Clean the appliance with a damp cloth with mild cleaner. Do not use chemical, steel, wooden or abrasive cleaners to clean the appliance.

WARNING: DO NOT IMMERSE THE APPLIANCE INTO WATER. ENSURE THAT THE FAN IS UNPLUGGED FROM THE POWER SUPPLY BEFORE REMOVING THE GUARD.
