Maturity:

- **Maincrop:** FAO 210

Characteristics/Quality:

- Enormous yield potential (**2010:** 20.5 t/ha DM*)
- Out performs existing mainstream varieties such as NK Bull and Nescio
- Early starch laydown – ahead of other varieties of similar maturity
- Ideal high yielding crimping maize (Grain Yield **2010:** 11.2 t/ha, **2011:** 14.6 t/ha)
