#### **CHOOSING FABRIC**

This style is designed for medium to heavy weight woven fabrics but can also be sewn in a lightweight woven for an oversized shirt. Choosing a thicker fabric or lining will reduce the ease so you may want to size up. If using flannel or fleece for the body lining, a slippery lining is recommended for the sleeves.

Minimum fabric required is listed. If you think you will need more for shrinkage, directional print, pattern matching or print repeat, please purchase accordingly.
