We served 2,014 club kids in 2022.

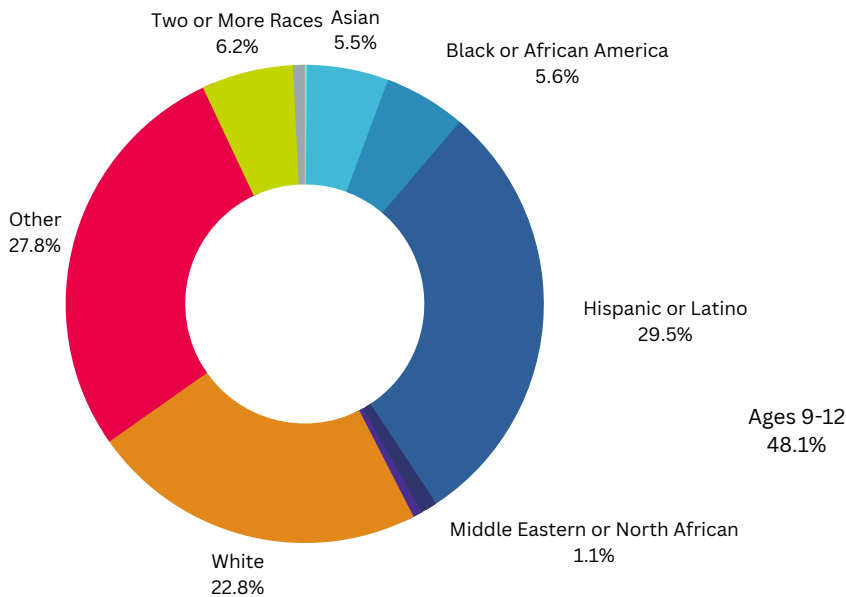
THE CLUB EXPERIENCE

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Stanislaus County fills the gap between home and school for families throughout our County. We provide a safe environment for students to learn and grow.

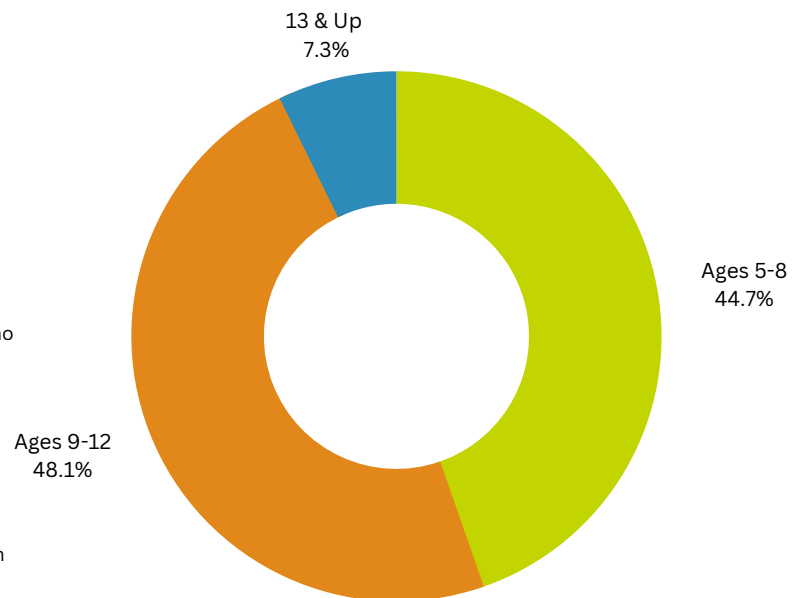
THE NEED IN OUR STATE

Ethnicities of the children we serve

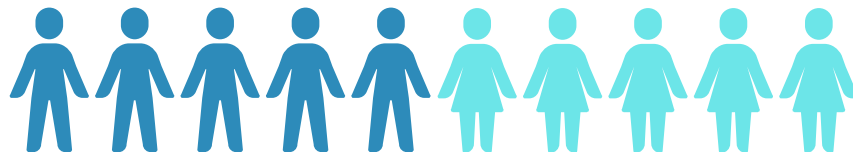


Students by age

of our club members feel the adults at our clubs care about them and encourage them to do their best.

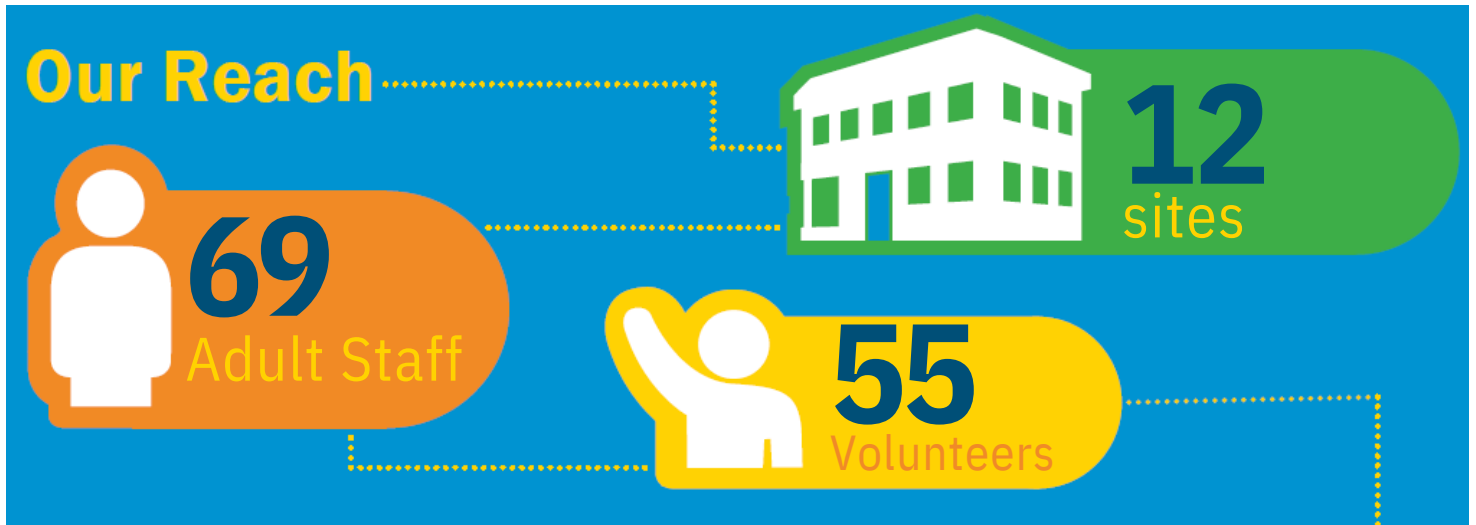

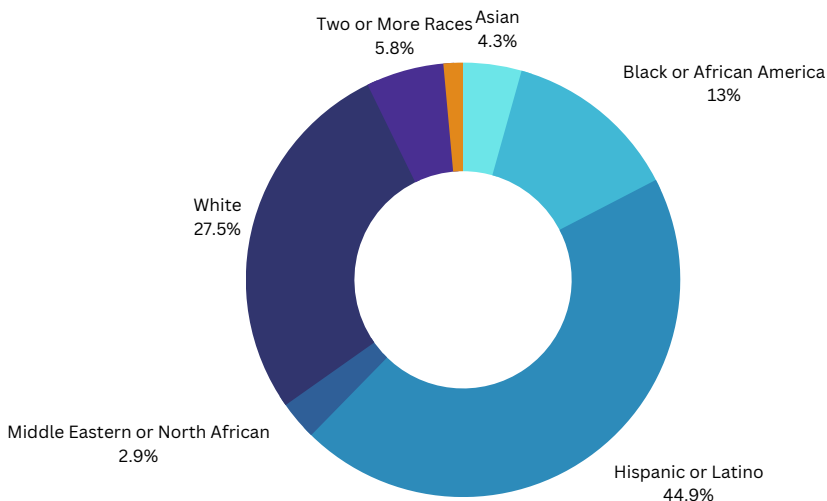


OUR MISSION
