

Never leave a harness buckled when not fitted to a child in the stroller because the harness can form loops which may pose a strangulation hazard.

It is unsafe to use accessories other than those approved by the vehicle manufacturer.

Care be taken if the stroller is used on stairs or escalators.

The stroller not be used near an open fire or exposed flame.

The brakes must always be applied when the stroller is not moving.

The vehicle is designed for use on flat or gently sloping surfaces and may unstable on higher sloping and uneven surfaces; and user should be made aware of the possibility of the vehicle tipping over.

There is potential for fingers or parts of the body to be injured when the vehicle is being folded or unfolded, and that due care should be exercised.

Ensure that the storage latch is engaged when lifting or carrying the vehicle.

Do not lift the stroller by the arm bar (supplied) because it may be disengaged.



Read these instructions carefully before use and keep them for future reference. Your child's safety may be affected if you do not follow these instructions:

This stroller is intended for children from birth to 48 months, up to 22kg (approximately 4 years old)

WARNING Regularly inspect all parts and locking devices, promptly replace worn out or broken parts.

WARNING Only use original accessories and manufacturer approved parts.

The use of non-approved replacement parts or accessories may cause damage or make your product unsafe.

WARNING Bumper bar must be removed before folding the stroller to avoid any damaged parts.

WARNING The maximum hold of the canopy pocket is 0.5kgs.

WARNING The maximum hold of the cup holder is 0.5kgs.

WARNING The maximum hold of the basket is 3kgs.

WARNING Store in a safe place away from children.






Open me up




1. Begin opening the stroller by releasing the plastic safety catch situated on the side



2. Lift the handles upwards




3. Secure the stroller by pushing the rear cross-bracing downwards




4. Ensure the cross-bracing is pressed all the way down before use

NOTE: Fingers or parts of the body could be injured when the stroller is being folded or unfolded. Please use caution when folding or unfolding the stroller.




1. Before folding the stroller close the hood and lower the backrest



2. Unlock the frame by pushing the rear cross-bracing upwards



3. Lower the secondary lock mechanism located to the right of the cross-bracing




4. Push the stroller handles forward until it is completely closed




5. carry the stroller by the handle strap after it is correctly closed.

Using the Brakes




1. To engage the brake, press down on either of the clips located over the back wheels. Push past the second click to fully engage the locking system and test to ensure the brakes are fully engaged




2. To release the brake, lift either of the clips upwards

Inserting and Removing the Bumper Bar



1. With the footbreak engaged, attach the bumper bar to the corresponding slots in the front of the stroller




2. Remove the bumper bar by pressing the button lock underneath and pulling it outwards


Note: The Discovery bumper bar has 4 sections to allow it to bend and for gate opening function. Do not attempt to lift the stroller by the bumper bar.


Using the Front Wheels



1. To assemble, ensure that the wheel lock mechanism is located at the top of the wheel, then insert each wheel, lock lever first, into the front of the pram until you hear a 'click'




2. To lock the front wheels into a fixed position, raise each of the lock levers found on the front of the wheels.




3. To unlock the wheels and allow for better manoeuvrability, lower each of the lock levers

WARNIG: THE WHEELS MUST ALWAYS BE BOTH FIXED OR BOTH SWIVEL FOR CORRECT USE OF THIS STROLLER. ENGAGE FRONT WHEEL SWIVEL LOCKS WHEN TRAVELLING ON ROUGH OR UNEVEN SURFACES.


Using the Safety Harness



1. Attach each of the 4 harness straps into the central buckle.



2. Adjust the length of each strap to ensure it fits nice and snug. Always give the harness a tug to ensure its secure.




3. To release press the button in the middle of the buckle.




- 1. To lengthen the harness strap, move the shoulder pad to find the harness adjuster tab.
- 2. Hold the top of the shoulder harness, near the seat in one hand, and slide the adjuster with the other hand to lengthen or shorten


Backrest Adjustment



1. Squeeze the adjustment clip located on the back of the seat




2. When the seat is in the desired position, release the clip to lock into place




3. The stroller has 3 position options: upright, reclined and sleeping

Leg rest Adjustment



1. Pull the two levers either side of the leg rest forwards



2. Push the leg rest downwards to lower, and pull upwards to raise

Wrist Tether Strap



1. Whenever a child is in the stroller and brakes are not engaged, the large loop should be around your wrist.

Care and Maintenance

Storage – Please store the stroller dry. Do not store the stroller in a damp or hot environment. Never leave in sunlight for prolonged periods as some fabrics may fade

Chassis - Always check the stroller for any wear or damage. Regularly lubricate all moving parts. Polish metal work with a clean dry cloth.

Wheels - Use a soft brush or cloth to clean

Seat Unit – Sponge clean with warm soapy water. Rinse with clean water to avoid staining. Dry naturally and away from direct heat and prolonged sunlight. Do not use strong detergents or bleach

Removable Canopy and Shopping basket - Handwash only up to 30degrees. Do not tumble dry. Wash items separately. Do not iron. Do not dry clean. Do not use strong detergents or bleach
