The Moon pushchair in pram mode is suitable for children from birth up to a maximum weight of 9kgs.

The Moon pushchair in seat mode is suitable for children from 6months up to a maximum weight of 20kgs.

WARNING: TO AVOID INJURY OR DEATH: ALWAYS APPLY THE BRAKES WHENEVER THE PRAM/STROLLER IS STATIONARY.

- DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN UNATTENDED.
- SECURE THE CHILD IN THE HARNESS AT ALL TIMES.
- DO NOT CARRY EXTRA CHILDREN OR BAGS ON THIS PRAM/STROLLER.
- MAKE SURE CHILDREN ARE CLEAR OF ANY MOVING PARTS IF YOU ADJUST THE PRAM/STROLLER.

WARNING: USE THIS HARNESS AT ALL TIMES.

WARNING: USE THIS STRAP TO STOP THE PRAM/STROLLER ROLLING AWAY.

This stroller has been designed for use on flat or gently slopped surfaces. Using this stroller on uneven or higher sloped surface may cause the stroller to become unstable and tip over.

WARNING Ensure that all locking devices are engaged before use.

WARNING Use the tether strap to prevent the stroller rolling away.

WARNING Never leave safety harness connected when not fitted to a child in the stroller, as this may create loops that cause a strangulation hazard.

WARNING Fingers or parts of the body could be injured when the stroller is being folded or unfolded. Please use caution when folding or unfolding the stroller.

WARNING To avoid injury ensure that your child is kept away when folding and unfolding the stroller.

WARNING Never leave a child in the pram/stroller when ascending or descending stairs or escalators. Use great care when using the stroller on other moving surfaces.

WARNING Do not allow children to stand on the seat or footrest.

WARNING Do not attempt to lift the stroller by the bumper bar.

WARNING Engage front wheel swivel locks when travelling on rough or uneven surfaces.

WARNING Regularly inspect all parts and locking devices, promptly replace worn out or broken parts.

WARNING Use only those accessories which are supplied by Ickle Bubba and approved for use with this stroller.


WARNING To prevent the risk of the stroller catching fire, do not park it near an open fire, heater or barbecue.

WARNING Do not run or jog with this stroller.

WARNING Shopping basket capacity should not be more than 3kg.

Assembly - Parts



Assembly - Opening the Frame



1. Unhook the latch, located on the right hand side of the frame




2. Lift the handlebar in the direction of the arrow until the frame locks into place.

Assembly - Installing the Rear Wheels



1. Insert the axle through each rear wheel, with the axle going through the break cluster on the wheel first.



2. Fix the smallest locking cap at the end of the axle to lock the wheel on, then repeat with the hub cap. Repeat this for both wheels, ensuring both sides are securely locked in place.



3. Once the wheels are fixed onto the axle, place the axle onto the frame of the chassis. Push it upwards until you hear a 'click' on both sides



4. To remove the rear wheel axle, push both the metal push pin clips inward, and slide downwards until the axle is clear of the chassis.

Assembly - Installing the Front Wheels



1. Push each front wheel onto the front wheel bayonet until you hear a 'click'. Ensure it is securely attached to the stroller before use.



2. To remove the front wheels, locate the release button which can be found at the top of the wheel bayonet, on the inner side. Push the button in firmly and the wheel will disengage.

Assembly - Using the Bumper Bar



1. Align the bumper bar with the fitting on the frame and push inwards until you hear a 'click' on each side and see the safety release buttons are in the raised position.



2. To remove, press each of the safety release buttons (indicated above) and pull the bumper bar outwards.

Assembly - Using the Harness



1. Insert both shoulder strap fasteners securely into the loops located on the side straps



2. Press the two side straps into the centre clasp until both sides are clicked in securely. Adjust each strap length as required.



3. To undo the harness, press the buckles in the centre of the harness and pull apart.

Adjusting Harness Height



1. The harness can be set at three heights



2. To use the slot, and slots to undo the buckle and feed the shoulder straps in through the chosen loop.



3. Secure the harness.

Assembly - Installing the Pram Hood



1. Insert the frame of the metal hood into the corresponding receptors located on the pram frame.




2. Align the zip located on the rear side of the hood to the zip found the pram/seat unit fabric and fasten.

Operating the Brakes



1. To engage the brake, apply a light downward pressure to the brake lever. Ensure that the brakes have been applied correctly and that the stroller will not move.



2. To release the breakes, gently lift up the brake lever.

Operating the Front Wheel Lock



1. Pull the lever located at the rear of the front wheel inwards towards the pram to engage the front wheel lock.



2. To release the lock, pull the lever outwards. Note that each wheel will require the lever to be pulled in a different direction - inwards & outwards, and not left or right.



Tether Strap



1. Whenever a child is in the stroller and brakes are not engaged, the large loop should be around your wrist.

Care and Maintenance

To clean the fabrics, please refer to the washing label which is located on the rear side of the stroller.

Clean periodically the fabric, plastic and metal parts with a damp cloth. Then dry with a soft and dry cloth to prevent rust from the metal parts.

MAINTENANCE

- Apply dry silicone oil on any moving parts of the stroller when needed.
- Check your stroller regularly. If any parts (like bolts, screws, wheels fabric pieces or stitching) are found to be loose, broken or damaged, always contact your retailer to arrange a repair.
- Where damage or dysfunction occurs, stop using the stroller.
- Do not leave the stroller in direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time to avoid colour fade.
- Check caster bolts and wheel axles periodically and replace any damaged parts immediately.
