Help younger children memorize verses and engage in family devotions. Original illustrations include Bible stories brought to life, children in real-life moments, and nature scenes.

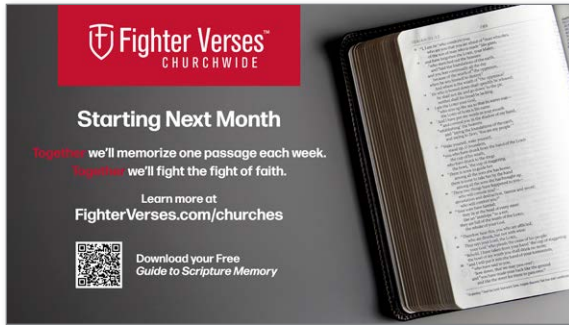
Verse cards or binders

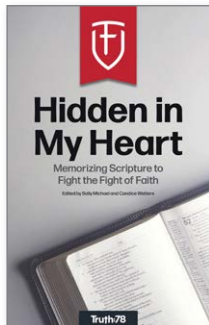

Two Weeks Before Launch

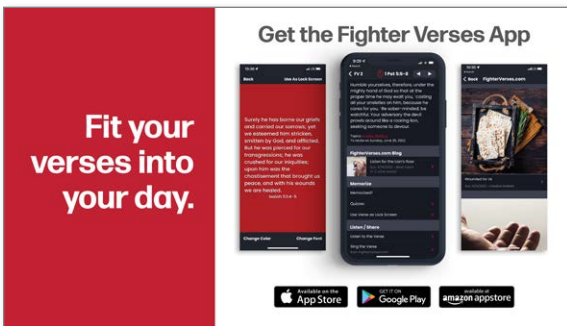
- Promote free download of **“Fighter Verses Guide to Scripture Memory”** with slide and/or bulletin insert.



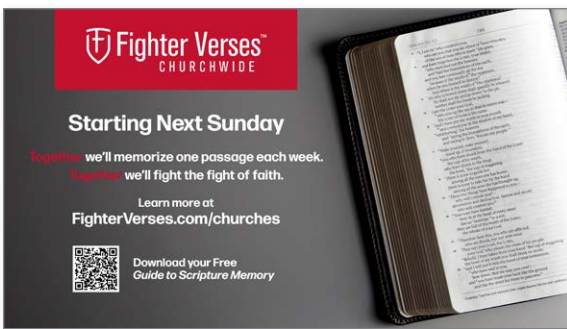
- Print copies of the Fighter Verses bookmark with list of references and check boxes so members can keep track of their progress. (**Fighter Verses bookmark**)

- Run **“Starting Next Sunday”** bulletin announcement/slide.

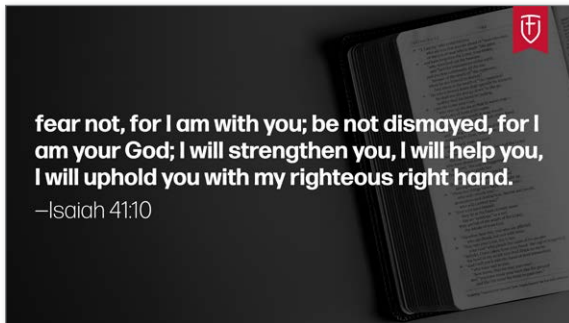


- Optional: Distribute **Fighter Verses Journals** for members to use alongside memorizing verses.

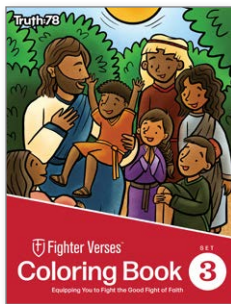


Launch Sunday

- Include the importance of Scripture memory during morning service, possibly even preaching a sermon on Bible memory.
- Display verse slide for week 1 (Set 3 image shown).



- Distribute verse [coloring page](#) for week 1, or copies of the [Fighter Verses Coloring Book](#) to families with young children. (Coloring books available for sets 1, 2, and 3.)



Weekly

- Each week, display the corresponding verse slide (screen, bulletin, and/or church website).
- Distribute verse coloring page to children.
- Ask volunteers to recite the previous week’s passage in the service.
