A NOTE TO PARENTS

This book is a companion to *Good News of Great Joy Family Advent Calendar* and *Readings*, published by Truth78. As such, it can be used in several ways:

- As a resource for a very young child in the family who will need help understanding the main point of the Bible reading for the day.
- As a review of key points and facts of the daily Bible passages. You might choose to do only the section corresponding to the daily reading, or you might choose to review previous pages either by reading parts of the text or by talking about the content using your own wording.
- If you have no older children and will not be reading the Scripture portion or only part of the Scripture portion on the Advent calendar cards, you could choose to use the book as the main teaching tool and reveal the calendar cards each day.

However you decide to use the book, we recommend reading just one section each day. Look at the picture with your child. Read the words, stopping to explain any words or concepts your child does not understand. Discuss the biblical truths and work of God revealed in the text. Pray with your child. Your child can then reveal the picture on the calendar for the day.

If you are also reading the Scripture portions in the Family Advent Calendar and Readings with children in the family, you could follow up with the corresponding pages in this book, or you could start with the pages in this book and then do the corresponding readings in the Family Advent Calendar and Readings. You may want to quickly review the main point of previous pages as you continue along in the book. The book and calendar content can also be reviewed using the Good News of Great Joy Coloring Book.

This book can be used alone or alongside the *Good News of Great Joy Family Advent Calendar and Readings* as well as a related coloring book. It is not intended to be read through in one sitting. Ideally, it is to be used as a daily Advent devotional by reading and discussing the sections for the corresponding dates in December.
