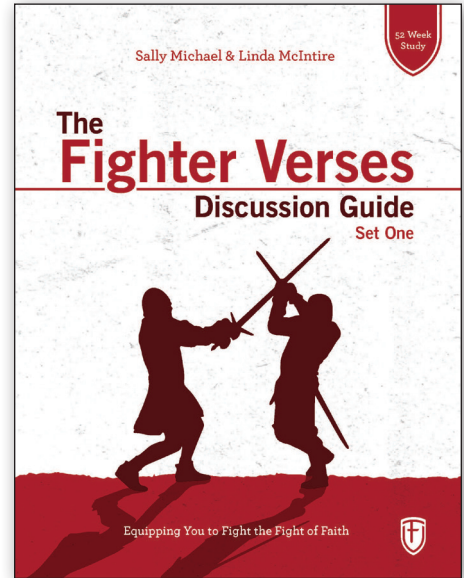




# The Fighter Verses Study, Set One, Part C

## *Equipping You to Fight the Fight of Faith*



Building relationships that are deep, lasting, and meaningful requires time spent listening and talking together. Nurturing a relationship with God is no different. **The Fighter Verses Study** is a year-long devotional that will help you spend quality "bites" of time with God as you study the verses found in Set One of the Fighter Verses Bible memory program.

The quarterly version of **The Fighter Verses Study** includes 13 lessons from the year-long study. Each quarterly study can be done in order following the year-long schedule, or you can study the parts independently in any order. Part C includes Fighter Verses 27-39.

**Fighter Verses 27: Ephesians 6:12-13**

*Spiritual Warfare*

For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. <sup>13</sup>Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm.

**Fighter Verses 28: Ephesians 6:14-15**

*Spiritual Warfare*

Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, <sup>15</sup>and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace.

**Fighter Verses 29: Ephesians 6:16-17 [18]**

*Spiritual Warfare*

In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; <sup>17</sup>and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, [<sup>18</sup>praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints,]

**Fighter Verses 30: Philippians 1:6**

*Security in God*

And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

**Fighter Verses 31: Matthew 10:28**

*Battling Fear*

And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

**Fighter Verses 32: Romans 1:16 [17]**

*Gospel*

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. [<sup>17</sup>For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."]

Fighter Verses 33: **Matthew 11:28-30**

*Depending on Christ*

“Come to me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup>Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup>For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”

---

Fighter Verses 34: **Psalms 20:6-7 [8]**

*Trusting God*

Now I know that the LORD saves his anointed; he will answer him from his holy heaven with the saving might of his right hand. <sup>7</sup>Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God. [<sup>8</sup>They collapse and fall, but we rise and stand upright.]

---

Fighter Verses 35: **James 1:12**

*Endurance*

Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.

---

Fighter Verses 36: **2 Corinthians 9:6-7**

*Generosity*

The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. <sup>7</sup>Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

---

Fighter Verses 37: **2 Corinthians 9:8**

*Generosity*

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.

---

Fighter Verses 38: **2 Corinthians 12:9 [10]**

*Depending on Christ*

But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. [<sup>10</sup>For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.]

Fighter Verses 39: **Isaiah 64:4**

*Waiting on God*

From of old no one has heard or perceived by the ear, no eye has seen a God besides you, who acts for those who wait for him.
