"You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." (Psalm 16: 11)

Dear Partner in Prayer,

Each month, I join a Zoom call with a few brothers and sisters in Christ to intercede for the persecuted church and those who are in prison

because of their faith. The people on the call are from a variety of age groups, ethnicities, and backgrounds. Many join after full days working in demanding careers, serving in important ministries, or managing busy households.

We meet in the name of Jesus to quote Scripture and raise our voices to our Sovereign Lord, who hears our cry for help and whose steadfast love for His people endures forever. As these group members cultivate a life of prayer and share encouragement from God's Word, we rejoice together to see God at work answering our prayers and sustaining His people.

Participating in these Zoom calls reminds me of you and your commitment to pray. Thank you for being a part of a growing number of prayer partners who regularly pray big, bold, and biblical prayers for the next generation—whether individually or in groups like this. We hope these communications serve as an encouragement to keep praying and to give you new insights for how to pray from Scripture.

Psalm 16

Psalm 16 has recently been on my heart to pray for the next generation. In this psalm, David reminds us that our security is found in God alone. What a great truth for children and students to embrace! Here are some suggested prayer points from this passage for the next generation:

- Pray that they would take refuge in God and recognize that there is no good apart from the goodness that they seek and find in Him (vv. 1-2).
- Pray that they would see God's hand in their circumstances of life and delight in His will for them both now and in the life to come (vv. 5-6).
- Pray that they would turn to God's Word for counsel and instruction and follow it throughout their whole lives (v. 7).

- Pray that they would have glad hearts and rejoice in the hope of heaven (vv. 9-10).
- Pray that they would find joy and satisfaction in God for now and all of eternity (v. 11).

Let's Pray Together

Lord Jesus,

Thank you that You are God and have graciously given us Your Word. We have no good apart from You, Lord, but your mercy has set us free. Blessed be Your name, forever! Help us to remember that You will preserve us, as we take refuge in You and persevere in prayer. Grant that the next generation will hear Your Truth, understand their great need for Jesus, and rejoice in the good news of the gospel, by taking refuge in You.

Make known to them the path of life. May You be their chosen portion and inheritance forever. May their ears be opened to Your counsel and establish them in Your love, so that they will not be shaken when difficulties come but will cast their burdens on You. Let Your Word sink deep in their souls, so that their lives will produce much fruit for Your Kingdom.

Then, Lord, by Your grace and for Your glory grant that our children will know the fullness of joy in Your presence and pleasures and Your right hand forevermore.

For it is in the name of Jesus that we pray, Amen!
