NOTES: Biblical Overview of Mightily used Young People

- * Throughout scripture God's way has always been to call ordinary young people to do hard things through His power for His glory:
- 1. **Joseph** 17 yrs. old (Gen. 39:9)
 - Rejected sexual sin when alone with an older woman!
- 2. **Samuel** 13 yrs old (I Sam. 3:1)
 - Spoke hard truth to adopted father Eli as a prophet for God's glory!
- 3. David 15 years old (I Samuel 17)
 - Slayed Goliath for the honor of God's name!
- 4. Esther as a young woman (Esther 2:15)
 - Risked her head before the king for the sake of God's people!
- 5. **Josiah** 16 yrs. old (2 Chron. 34:2-3)
 - Lived righteous before the Lord (8 yrs. old) as King of Judah and pursued hard after God (16 yrs. old)!
- 6. **Daniel** 14 yrs old (Daniel 1:8)
 - Resolved to remain pure in an evil culture for God's glory!
- 7. **Mary** 16 yrs old (Luke 1:26-31)
 - Remained a virgin and trusted God's crazy promise of a Holy Spirit conception to birth the Son of God!

NOTES: Warning from a Wise King!

*5 warnings from Solomon (who said, "Remember, worship, serve while young"! (Eccl. 12:1) to encourage youth to answer God's call here and now, while they are young instead of waiting until later:

- 1) You might die young! (Eccl. 7:17)
- 2) Your strongest years are wasted when you wait! (Eccl. 12:3)
- 3) Your life young or old is utter nothingness w/o God! (Eccl. 11:10)
- 4) Your heart may likely get harder, not softer as u get older! (Eccl. 12:1)
- 5) You will be judged for these wasted years! (Eccl. 11:9)
