What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Bamboo Ice™,
Size 3: 1 ball 3631 Green Tea Ice

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
3.25mm [US D/3]

One 7/8" (2.2 cm) or 1" (2.5 cm)
decorative button, yarn needle,
stitch markers

GAUGE: 8 repeats of Rows 5 and
6 = 4" (10cm), 8 sts = 1 1/8" (3cm).
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any
size hook needed to obtain the
gauge given.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Bamboo Ice™,
96% Viscose from Bamboo 4%
Metallic Size 3 Art 147M available
100 yd (147m) balls

Button Showcase Bracelet

*This fun and quick thread project is perfect for
gift giving. Show off your favorite buttons by
making a bracelet for each one.*

Bracelet measures 7" x 1 1/8" (17.8 x 2.9 cm)

Special Abbreviations

dc2tog [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch,
yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and
draw through 2 loops on hook] twice, yarn
over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

dc3tog [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch,
yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and
draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times, yarn
over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

Bracelet is made by first working button circle
in continuous rounds. Band is then worked
in turned rows from one side of the circle,
alternating rows of crossed dc and sc.

BRACELET

Button Circle

Round 1: Leaving long tail for sewing, ch 2, 6
sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each st around—12 sc.

Round 3: [Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] 6
times; join with slip st in next st—18 sc.

Band

Note: Work now progresses in turned rows.

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in same
st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next
st, 2 hdc in next st, leaving remaining sts
unworked—4 hdc and 4 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across—8 sts.

Row 6 (Right Side): Ch 3 (counts as dc),
skip first st, [skip next st, dc in next st, dc in
skipped st] 3 times, dc in last st.

Row 7: Repeat Row 5.

Rows 8-27: Repeat Rows 6-7, 10 times.

Row 28: Ch 2, turn, skip first st, dc2tog, ch 3,
skip 2 sts (button hole made), dc3tog—2 sts
and 1 ch-3 space.

Row 29: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 5 sc in ch-3
space, sc in next st, slip st in top of beginning
ch-2—8 sts.

FINISHING

Using photo as a guide, sew button to center
of Button Circle with Right Side facing. Weave
in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half
double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single
crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions
in brackets the number of times specified.
