



What you will need:

Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball each 401 Orchid Pink A and 661 Frosty Green B

Susan Bates® Steel Crochet Hook: 1.5mm [US 7 steel]

Tapestry needle, fishhook earring wires, post earring findings (optional), glue gun & stick (optional)

GAUGE: 3 sts = .25" (6.35 mm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white & ecru 400 yd; solid color 250 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls



Rosebud Earrings

Perfect in any color, these crocheted rosebud earrings will complete a formal or more casual outfit. They can be made quickly with crochet thread for a gift or special event. Earring measures approximately 1" (2.5 cm) x 11/4" (3.2 cm)

Note

Rosebud will form as Row 1 is worked.

EARRINGS

Rosebud (Make 2)

With A. ch 9.

Row 1 (Right Side): 5 dc in 4th ch from hook, 5 dc in each remaining ch across, slip st in top of dc adjacent to last dc made (Rosebud formed). Fasten off and weave in ends.

Leaf (Make 2)

With B, ch 5.

Round 1: Slip st in first ch to form ring, *ch 3, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, (dc, slip st) in ring; repeat from * 4 times, slip st in joining slip st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

FINISHING

To assemble, lay 1 Rosebud and 1 Leaf, wrong sides together. Sew or glue (optional) Rosebud and Leaf together. Weave in ends. Sew assembled Rosebud and Leaf onto earring wire. Optional: If using a post finding, glue or sew assembled Rosebud and Leaf to post.
