## What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball 226 Natural

Susan Bates® Steel Crochet Hook: 1.65mm [US-7]

Tapestry needle, 1 box Crystazzi Round Pearl Matte Rose 6mm glass pearl beads in ivory, 1 silver barrel clasp, 2 silver crimps, silver beading wire, 1 6mm silver jump ring, 2 clear seed beads, ivory sewing thread, beading needle, 2 silver fishhook earring wires, needle nosed pliers

**GAUGE:** Earring=1" (2.5 cm) in diameter. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white and ecru 400 yd (368 m) and solid color 350 yd (322 m) and shaded color 300 yd (276 m) balls.

# Pearly Crochet Jewelry

*Combine your love of crochet with beading to create these elegant accessories. Simple circles combine with pearls for a unique accent for any wardrobe.*

Pendant measures 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (4.8 x 5.7 cm).  
Earring measures 1" x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (2.5 x 3.2 cm).  
Necklace measures 17" (43 cm) long.

**NOTE:** All circles are worked with Right Side facing. Always join with slip st in first st.

## NECKLACE

Insert first end of beading wire through a crimp, thread through one end of barrel clasp, and back through crimp; pinch crimp shut firmly with pliers; trim wire end if necessary. String enough ivory glass pearls onto beading wire to make a 17" (43 cm) strand (or any length desired); trim wire to 2" (5 cm) past the last bead, insert end through a crimp, through the second end of barrel clasp, and back through crimp; pinch crimp shut firmly with pliers; trim wire end if necessary.

## Pendant

### Large Circle

Ch 5 (first ch-4 counts as first tr), work 17 tr in 5th ch from hook; join – 18 tr. Fasten off.

### Medium Circle

Ch 4 (first ch-3 counts as first dc), work 17 dc in 4th ch from hook; join – 18 dc. Fasten off, leaving long sewing end.

### Small Circle

Ch 3, work 18 hdc in third ch from hook; join – 18 hdc. Fasten off, leaving long sewing end.

## Assembly

Using long sewing end on Medium Circle, sew Medium Circle to Large Circle. Using long sewing end on Small Circle, sew Small Circle to Medium Circle opposite first joining. Weave in all ends. Starch if desired.

## EARRING (Make 2)

Ch 12, join with slip st in first ch to make ring.  
**Round 1:** Ch 4 (counts as first tr), work 24 tr in ring; join, ch 10 for earring wire loop, skip next tr, slip st in next tr – 25 tr. Fasten off. Starch if desired.

## FINISHING

With needle nosed pliers, open jump ring, insert in center top of Large Circle of Pendant, close over completed necklace. With beading needle threaded with ivory sewing thread, sew a single pearl to bottom center of each earring, using a seed bead as anchor. With needle nosed pliers, open fishhook earring wires, close over each earring's ch-10 loop.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **tr** = treble (triple) crochet.
