

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =
Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet
Rep = Repeat
Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 13" [33 cm] long x ¾" [2 cm] wide, excluding clasp and chain.

GAUGE

36 sc and 40 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 116.

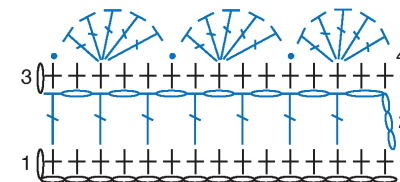
1st row: (WS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 115 sc.

2nd row: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1). Skip next sc. *1 dc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Skip first 2 sc. *5 dc in next sc. Skip next sc. Sl st in next sc. Skip next 2 sc. Rep from * to last 3 sc. 5 dc in next sc. Skip next sc. Sl st in last sc. Fasten off.

Using a 7mm jump ring, connect one end of Choker to metal chain. Using second 7mm jump ring, connect necklace clasp to other end of Choker.

STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ⊕ = single crochet (sc)
- ⌈ = double crochet (dc)

MATERIALS

Aunt Lydia's® Crochet Thread Classic™ 10 (400 yds/366 m)

White (154-0001)

1 ball

Size No. 2 (1.5 mm) Steel crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Two 7mm jump rings. One necklace clasp. 4" [10 cm] metal chain.
