MATERIALS

Aunt Lydia's[®] Crochet Thread Classic[™] 10 (Colors: 300 yds/274.32 m) Copper Mist (0310) 1 ball

Size U.S. 9 [1.25 mm] Susan Bates[®] steel crochet hook. Big-eye sewing needle. Stuffing. Earring Wires. Jump rings. Anchor[®] Floss (4735.0023) for embroidery

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Rem = Remaining
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook St(s) = Stitch(es) Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENT

Approx $\frac{1}{2}$ " [1.25 cm] diameter, excluding earring wire.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Earrings are worked in continuous rnds. Move marker as you work.

See Diagrams on page 2. **Cat Head**

Make magic ring.

1st rnd: 6 sc into magic ring. **Do not** join. Work in continuous rnds. PM for beg of rnd. 6 sc. **2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc. **4th to 6th rnds:** 1 sc in each sc around. Stuff lightly. 7th rnd: (Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc) 6 times. 12 sts. 8th rnd: (Sc2tog) 6 times. 6 sts. Fasten off leaving long end. Weave long end through rem 6 sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely.

Cat Ears (Make 2) Ch 2. 1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn. 1 sc. 2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in sc. 2 sc. Fasten off, leaving long end for sewing to Cat Head. Sew Ears to top of Head.

FINISHING

Attach jump ring to top behind Ears. Attach second jump ring to first jump ring.

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Attach third jump ring to second jump ring, then attach to earring wire.

With embroidery Floss embroider whiskers and nose using straight stitch.
