What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Baker's Cotton:
6 balls 700 Pink

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 20 dc = 4" (10 cm) with
thread held double. **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.

Summer Day's Shawl

This easy shawl is perfect for days when your arms are bare and the air-conditioning is cold. Crocheted with two strands of Baker's Cotton, it is a comfortable way to add a bit of style to a plain outfit. And it's a lovely gift idea!

Triangle Shawl measures 47" wide x 22" deep (119 cm x 56 cm)

Shawl

With thread held double, ch 8. Slip st in 6th ch from hook, ch 5, slip st in next ch, ch 3, dc in last ch. Turn.

Row 1: Ch 5, slip st in same ch-space, ch 5, slip st in next ch-space, ch 5 slip st in same ch-space (mark this ch-space), ch 5, slip st in last ch-space, ch 3, dc in same ch-space. Turn.

Rows 2-35: Ch 5, slip st in same ch-space, work (ch 5, slip st in next ch-space) to marked ch-space, ch 5, slip st in same ch-space (mark this ch-space), work (ch 5, slip st in next ch-space) to last ch-space, ch 5, slip st in last ch-space, ch 3, dc in same ch-space. Turn.

Edging

Row 1: *Ch 1, (dc, ch 5, dc) in next ch-5 space; repeat from *, ending with sc in last ch-5 space. Turn.

Row 2: Slip st in first ch-5 space, ch 3, 4 dc in same ch-5-space, *skip next ch-1 space, 5 dc in next ch-5 space; repeat from *, ending with sc in beginning ch-1 of last row. Turn.

Row 3: *Ch 3, slip st in next dc, (skip next dc, ch 3, slip st in next dc) twice; repeat from * to end. Fasten off.

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **sl st** = slip stitch; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
