What you will need:
AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circ}$ Fashion Crochet size 3: $10(12,13,15,16,18)$ balls 310 Copper Mist

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circ}$ Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: $16 \mathrm{sc}=4^{\prime \prime}$ ( 10 cm ); 24 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Fashion Crochet size 3, Art. 182 available 100\% Mercerized Cotton, 150 yd (147m) balls


## Flower Hill Pullover

Choose your favorite shade of this thicker size 3 thread and crochet a top that is as fashionable as it is comfortable. The $100 \%$ mercerized cotton is wonderful to wear and makes hemline fringe that
is the perfect finish.

## Directions are for size Small. Changes for sizes Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, and 3X are in parentheses.

Finished Bust: 36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56)" [91.5 (101.5, 112, 122, 132, 142) cm]

Finished Length: $23(231 / 2,24,241 / 2,25,251 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ [58.5 $(59.5,61,62,63.5,65) \mathrm{cm}$ ]

## PULLOVER

## Front/Back Panel (make 2)

Loosely ch 73 (81, 89, 97, 105, 113)
Row 1 (right side): Working in back loops, sc in 2 nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn-72 (80, 88, 96, 104, 112) sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, working in back loops, sc in each st across, turn.
Rows 3-6: Repeat Row 2.
Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.
Rows 8-10: Repeat Row 7.
Rows 11 and 12: Ch 4 (counts as first tr here and throughout), tr in each st across, turn.
Rows 13 and 14: Repeat Row 7.
Rows 15 and 16: Repeat Rows 11 and 12.
Rows 17-24: Repeat Row 7.
Rows 25 and 26: Repeat Rows 11 and 12.
Rows 27-34: Repeat Row 7.
Repeat Rows 11-34 until piece measures 22
$(221 / 2,23,23112,24,241 / 2)^{\prime \prime}[56(57,58.5,59.5,61$,
62) cm ] ending with a WS row.

Next 7 rows: Repeat Row 2.
Leaving a long tail for sewing, fasten off.

## Sleeve (make 2)

Ch 37 (39, 41, 43, 45, 47).
Work same as Front increasing 1 st at each end every $1(1,3 / 4,3 / 4,3 / 4,3 / 4)$ " $[2.5(2.5,2,2,2,2)$ cm] $18(19,20,21,22,23)$ times- $72(76,80$, $84,88,92)$ sts.
Work even in pattern until sleeve measures $20^{\prime \prime}$ ( 51 cm ). Leaving a long tail for sewing, fasten off.

## FINISHING

Beginning at outer edges, sew Panels together $4(5,6,7,8,9)$ " $10(12.5,15$, $18,20.5,23) \mathrm{cm}$ ] across top edge. Sew Sleeves to Front and Back, then sew side and Sleeve seams.
Weave in ends.

## Fringe

For each fringe, cut 6 strands, each $18^{\prime \prime}$ $(45.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ long. Fold strands in half to form a loop. Insert crochet hook from right side in first st of Row 1 of Front Panel. Place fold on hook and draw fold through, forming a loop. Thread ends of strands through loop and pull to tighten. Repeat to attach fringe every $1^{\prime \prime}(2.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ around bottom edge or as desired. Trim ends evenly.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathbf{c h}=$ chain $(\mathrm{s}) ; \mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); tr = treble (triple) crochet; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
